RE: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Ms. Martin,

The Village of Elmwood Park is in receipt of your April 4, 2016, Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 et seq.) ("FOIA") for the following records:

**"16-748"**

Enclosed are records responsive to your request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records being provided has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA, and that information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee id number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses." Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "personal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, such as the victim's name and identifying information, have been redacted from the records being provided.

In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General's Office.

You are also notified that you have the right to judicial review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer pursuant to Section II of FOIA.

THE INFORMATION BELOW IS CONFIDENTIAL - FOR USE BY AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY

ON MARCH 31, 2016, MARIA MARTIN CAME TO THE ELMWOOD PARK POLICE STATION TO REPORT A RESIDENTIAL BURGLARY TO HER RESIDENCE LOCATED AT 7335 W FULLERTON AVENUE, UNIT GARDEN SOUTH.

MARIA ADVISED ME SHE HAD GONE ON VACATION TO PERU ON DECEMBER 09, 2015 AND RETURNED MARCH 21, 2016. MARIA SAID SHE NOTICED A PLANT STAND MOVED AWAY FROM THE WINDOW IN THE SOUTH EAST ROOM OF HER APARTMENT. MARIA DIDN'T THINK MUCH OF IT AND THOUGHT SHE MAY HAVE MOVED IT PRIOR TO HER LEAVING.

ON MARCH 28, 2016, MARIA NOTICED HER APPLE LAP TOP MISSING. MARIA THEN CHECKED HER RESIDENCE AND NOTICED HER GOLD JEWELRY, TWO BLACK LEATHER COATS HAD ALSO BEEN TAKEN. MARIA WAS GIVEN A SUPPLEMENTARY PROPERTY LIST AND ADVISED TO LIST HER ITEMS WITH A VALUE AND SERIAL NUMBER IF IT WAS AVAILABLE.

I WENT TO MARIA'S APARTMENT AND SHE SHOWED ME THE REAR SOUTH EAST WINDOW SHE FELT SOMEONE MAY HAVE ENTERED TO BURGLARIZE HER RESIDENCE. I NOTICE TWO HAND MARKS ON THE WINDOW AND FINGER PRINTS AROUND THE OUTSIDE OF THE WINDOW FRAME. MARIA ADVISED ME THE WINDOW WAS THE SAME ONE SHE HAD A PLANT SHELF IN FRONT OF THAT HAD BEEN MOVED.

I ADVISED SGT BROWN I WOULD NEED A EVIDENCE TECHNICIAN TO COME TO THIS ADDRESS TO LOOK AT THE HAND PRINTS. MARIA ADVISED ME SHE HAD ONLY MOVED THE PLANT SHELF AND DID NOT TOUCH THE WINDOW ARE WHERE THE HAND PRINTS ARE LOCATED.

EVIDENCE TECHNICIAN OFFICER GIOVENCO ARRIVED ON SCENE AND PHOTOGRAPHED THE BUILDING AND MARIA'S RESIDENCE WINDOW AREA. SEE OFFICER GIOVENCO'S REPORT.

I NOTICED A COUPLE WINDOWS ON MARIAS RESIDENCE HAD NOT BEEN LOCKED. MARIA ADVISED ME SHE DOES NOT LOCK THE WINDOWS AND SOMETIMES LEAVES THE WINDOWS OPEN FOR HER PLANTS TO BREATHE INSIDE HER RESIDENCE. MARIA STATED SHE HAD CLOSED THE WINDOWS, BUT MAY HAVE LEFT THIS ONE UNLOCKED. NO OTHER FORCED ENTRY WAS OBSERVED ON THE RESIDENCE.

I NOTICED EXTERIOR CAMERAS IN THE REAR OF 7335 W FULLERTON AVE. MARIA ADVISED ME HER NEIGHBOR IN UNIT GARDEN NORTH IN THE PERSON WHO MAY KNOW ABOUT THE CAMERAS.

I SPOKE TO .. ADVISED ME THE CAMERAS ARE FAKE. JAMES STATED HE HAS NOT SEEN ANYONE INSIDE OR OUTSIDE THE BUILDING IN THE LAST FEW MONTHS.

NO OTHER ACTION TAKEN AT THIS TIME.
