Re: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Mr. Martorana:

On March 21, 2016, the Village of Elmwood Park received your March 19, 2016, Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"Pursuant to the freedom of information act, I hereby request any and all invoices and costs related to the construction project of the bocce ball courts located on Conti Parkway in Elmwood Park. Please include all invoices regarding this project, along with engineering fees and bid process documentation."

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including signatures, have been redacted from the records being provided.







Hi Paul,

My son is having his wisdom teeth out tomorrow morning, so I may not get to you until the end of the day. The best scenario is you guys provide the excavation, drainage, sub-base and any concrete work (curbing, sidewalk, ADA access ramp). We come in and do the installation and provide the materials for the nailer boards, top layer of the base, turf and infill. You probably have a landscape architect who can look at the site, assess the soil and make a recommendation for the base materials, drainage and how the Bocce courts will drain since they have high sides and can become pools with insufficient drainage.

I can give you an exact quote once we agree on all the components and who will do what, but knowing you are looking for budget number, I'd expect our part as described above to cost between \$24,000 and \$28,000 including prevailing wage installation for 16 man-days. (Between \$11.50-12.50/sf for a sand infill Bocce court.)

Hopefully we'll get a chance to talk Monday afternoon, otherwise Tuesday morning I am available and will call you then to go over any of this.

It does. The turf comes 15' wide, so you would need two pieces 15 by 80 (2400sf) to make two 13 by 80 bocce courts. We would not recommend building public bocce courts with PerfectPutt 100. We have a Bocce 125 product that is like the PerfectPutt except ¼" higher, which means it can hold more silica sand which is needed to absorb the impact of the heavy bocce balls and protect the underlying base.

PS – I did hear your voicemail last night, sorry I couldn't get back to you, we were exhibiting at the iLandscape Show and mobbed the whole time. I will call you Monday.

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


BOCCE COURT LAYOUT
