RE: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Ms. Mensfeld,

The Village of Elmwood Park is in receipt of your December 2, 2016, Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 et seq.) ("FOIA") for the following records:

"09-1267, 09-1259"

Enclosed are copies of the records you requested. However, please be advised that certain information in the records being provided has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA, and that information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee id number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses." Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "personal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, such as the victim's name and identifying information, have been redacted from the records being provided.

In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General's Office.

Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this letter when filing a Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor. You are also notified that you have the right to judicial review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer pursuant to Section II of FOIA.

On 02/08/09 at 2009 hours, I was assigned a domestic battery report at the police station. Upon arrival, I talked to [redacted]. I had previously talked to [redacted] at 1541 hours when she came to the police station with her boyfriend, Lukasz T. Jureczko, over a verbal argument they were having (See RD# 09-1259).


[redacted] told me on 02/08/09 at approximately 1500 hours, [redacted] and Jureczko were walking on the sidewalk in front of 2415 N. 77th Av. [redacted] was pushing a baby stroller which contained their son, [redacted] and Jureczko was walking beside her. [redacted] stated she was upset and told Jureczko she was going to walk home with [redacted] stated Jureczko grabbed her right wrist and twisted it. [redacted] stated they walked to the police station where they later went their separate ways.

I saw no signs of physical injury to the right wrist of [redacted] d. [redacted] declined medical attention.

[redacted] told me she also wanted to document past incidents of abuse by Jureczko which occurred on the following dates:

1. 12/14/08 - [redacted] stated Jureczko kicked her all over her body and punched her one time in the face resulting in a swollen lip. Jureczko also took the telephone away from her when she attempted to call the police for help. She did not seek medical attention or photograph her injuries. No witnesses to the physical abuse.
2. 11/24/08 - [redacted] stated Jureczko kicked her out of the car at Fullerton and Central in Chicago, IL. Mensfeld walked home and Jureczko came to her house and kicked her repeatedly in the buttocks while she was lying down. She did not seek medical attention or photograph her injuries. No witnesses to the physical abuse.
3. 10/24/08 - [redacted] stated Jureczko punched her in the face one time during an argument. She did not seek medical attention or photograph her injuries. No witnesses to the physical abuse.

On 02/08/09 at 1541 hours, I was assigned station report for a domestic trouble incident. Upon arrival, I spoke with Lukasz T. JURECZKO and [redacted] Both parties indicated they had a dating relationship and were having an argument today over financial trouble (car repossession), fidelity issues and child visitation. The parties were never married and both denied existence of any court orders pertaining to visitation or custody. I saw no signs of physical injury to either party. JURECZKO told me that he wanted to spend more time with his son [redacted] who was currently with his parents at his residence. [redacted] agreed to allow JURECZKO to see the baby until 2000 hours today at which time JURECZKO agreed to drive [redacted] back to [redacted]'s residence. JURECZKO left the station without incident. I provided [redacted] with Illinois Domestic Violence Act information and information on how to obtain a Civil Order of Protection. [redacted] was picked up from the station by her step-father and left the area without incident. I completed my report and returned to patrol.
