On January 22, 2016, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for "15-2543[.]"

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, a driver's license number, home or personal telephone numbers, home addresses, and signatures, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, the names of third parties who incidentally appear in police reports, and the races of individuals, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Action Taken

The following is in summary and not verbatim.

On 13 March 2015, I entered the report room while Officer Marino interviewed [REDACTED] in reference to a harassment by telephone report. [REDACTED] asked Officer Marino to contact the offender, Eric Jarosz [REDACTED], and advise him to stop contacting her. Officer Marino left a voicemail message for Eric to stop contacting [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] subsequently received texts from Eric and displayed them to me on her cellular telephone. [REDACTED] told me she wanted to sign a complaint. While [REDACTED] sat in the report room, she received a telephone call from Eric. I answered the call and identified myself. Eric yelled as he spoke regarding [REDACTED]. I told Eric there was a signed complaint for his arrest and asked him if he would cooperate with the police. Eric continued to yell and told me to come alone and attempt to arrest him in the front of his residence. As Eric continued to yell I disconnected the call. I contacted Eric's [REDACTED] after [REDACTED] advised us Eric [REDACTED] told me Eric was [REDACTED]. I asked [REDACTED] if Eric possessed any weapons in the residence. [REDACTED] told me Eric possessed a rifle. I began speaking with officers including Inv Commander Klisz regarding an arrest plan to take custody of Eric. I received a call at the one of the desks from Eric. Eric yelled and told me he was in front of his residence and asked why I had not come to arrest him. Eric made reference to being able to kill people on his block.

I immediately responded to the area of Eric's residence located at 1626 77th Avenue with Inv Commander Klisz, Sergeant Brown and Officers Marino, Rodriguez and Barrile.

I requested paramedics stage in the area. Sgt. Brown and I took a position south of Eric's residence and I yelled toward Eric's residence in attempt to make contact with him. Eric walked from his front porch area to the common sidewalk. I ordered Eric to walk toward me to the south. Eric refused to follow the order. Eric pulled his shirt off, dropped down to his knees and placed his hands on top of his head and then behind his back as he yelled. Sgt. Brown and I approached Eric. I secured Eric in handcuffs, double locked them after checking for fit. Inv Commander Klisz obtained verbal consent to search Eric's residence. Eric advised Commander Klisz there was a dog in the residence. Commander Klisz, Officers Barrile and Rodriguez entered the residence and found it to be clear of any other persons including Eric's children, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED].

Officer Marino transported Eric to the police station lockup. (see connecting report)

Officer Barrile remained at the residence to wait for Eric's [REDACTED] (see connecting report #15-2544)

At the police station, I met with the paramedics and [REDACTED] upon her arrival. We spoke in the center report room.

[REDACTED] spoke with the paramedics regarding Eric's medical status and history. The paramedics determined Eric would be transported to the hospital.

Numerous officers including myself entered the lockup with the paramedics (Elmwood Park FD). Eric agreed to be transported to the hospital and laid on the transport stretcher. I handcuffed Eric's right wrist to the stretcher. Third watch Commander Busch ordered Officer Logisz to guard Eric at the hospital.

Detective Astrella was assigned to secure the telephone evidence. (see connecting report)


