**Re: Freedom of Information Act Request**

Dear Ms. Moeller:

On June 25, 2016, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"Police Report # 16-1428  
also need copy of jewelry items on same report # above[.]"

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including home or personal telephone numbers, a home address, and a signature, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal

privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, the name of a third-party property owner, and the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General's Office. You are also notified that you have the right to judicial review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer pursuant to Section 11 of FOIA.

THE INFORMATION BELOW IS CONFIDENTIAL - FOR USE BY AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY

ON 06-15-16 AT 1922 HOURS OFC RODRIGUEZ AND I WERE DISPATCHED TO A CALL OF A SUSPICIOUS AUTO, LATER CHANGED TO A BURGLARY AT 2837 N 73RD AVENUE. WE WERE INITIALLY ADVISED THE PROPERTY OWNER HAD CONTACT WITH MALES WHO STATED THEY WERE THERE TO PERFORM UNSCHEDULED "WORK" ON THE BUILDING. WE CHECKED THE AREA BUT WERE UNABLE TO LOCATED ANY INDIVIDUALS MATCHING THE GIVEN DESCRIPTION. A SHORT TIME LATER I WAS NOTIFIED A RESIDENT OF THE BUILDING HAD BEEN THE VICTIM OF A BURGLARY. UPON ARRIVAL I SPOKE WITH VICTIM [REDACTED] WHO RELAYED THE FOLLOWING:

AT APPROXIMATELY 1900 HOURS SHE HAD EXITED HER APARTMENT, [REDACTED] TO THROW AWAY HER TRASH. SHE THEN MADE HER WAY OUT FRONT ONTO 73RD AVENUE WHERE SHE MOVED HER CAR, PARKING IT IN FRONT OF 2837. AS SHE WALKED BACK INTO HER BUILDING SHE NOTICED A NEWER MODEL WHITE SUV PARKED NEARBY. THE SUV, WHICH MIGHT HAVE BEEN A HONDA CRV, HAD DARK TINTED WINDOWS. SHE SAW TWO INDIVIDUALS INSIDE THE VEHICLE WAVING AT HER. SHE DIDN'T RECOGNIZE THEM AND WAS NOT ABLE TO SEE THEM WELL THROUGH THE DARK WINDOWS. SHE CONTINUED ON HER WAY INSIDE.

BEFORE SHE WAS ABLE TO ENTER THROUGH THE SOUTH ENTRANCE OF THE BUILDING A MALE APPROACHED FROM BEHIND HER AND BEGAN SPEAKING WITH HER. THE MALE, WHOM SHE DESCRIBED AS BEING DARK SKINNED, BUT NOT AFRICAN AMERICAN, WAS APPROXIMATELY 5'10" AND 250 TO 300 LBS. HE WAS WEARING A MEDIUM BLUE BASEBALL CAP, A DARK BLUE SHIRT, AND BLACK PANTS. THE MALE ASKED HER IF SHE REMEMBERED HIM, TELLING HER HE HAD DONE WORK ON THE BUILDING THE PREVIOUS YEAR. [REDACTED] ADVISED HIM SHE DID NOT RECOGNIZE HIM. THE MALE THEN PROCEEDED TO TELL [REDACTED] HE WOULD BE RETURNING IN THE MORNING TO FIX CRACKS IN THE FOUNDATION OF THE BUILDING AND THE WALL OF THE GARAGE. HE BEGAN POINTING OUT CRACKS AND DAMAGE ALONG THE SIDE OF THE BUILDING. HE THEN DIRECTED [REDACTED] TO THE GARAGE AND ASKED HER TO HELP HIM MEASURE A CRACK IN THE WALL. HE CONTINUED TO KEEP [REDACTED] ATTENTION ON HIM AS HE WALKED INTO THE ALLEY AND POINTED OUT ADDITIONAL CRACKS. WHEN [REDACTED] ATTEMPTED TO WALK AWAY AND RETURN INSIDE, HE ASKED HER TO GET HIM A PALE AND SOME WATER. [REDACTED] GRANTED THE MALE ACCESS TO THE BASEMENT LAUNDRY AREA AND THEN TRIED TO WALK BACK UPSTAIRS TO HER APARTMENT. THE MALE AGAIN BEGAN TALKING TO HER AND DIRECTING HER BACK OUTSIDE. [REDACTED], WHO WAS BECOMING WORRIED AT THIS POINT, MADE HER WAY TO HER NEIGHBOR'S GARAGE WHERE SHE SAW HIM WORKING OUTSIDE. SHE LAST SAW THE MALE WALKING OUT OF THE GANGWAY BACK TOWARDS 73RD AVENUE.

[REDACTED] RETURNED TO HER APARTMENT AND CALLED HER LANDLORD [REDACTED] VIA AT [REDACTED] INFORMED HER NO ONE WAS SCHEDULED TO DO WORK ON THE BUILDING AND ADVISED HER TO CALL THE POLICE. ONCE INSIDE HER APARTMENT, WHICH SHE HAD LEFT UNLOCKED, [REDACTED] MADE HER WAY TO HER BEDROOM AND NOTICED ITEMS ON HER DRESSER HAD BEEN DISTURBED. UPON FURTHER EXAMINATION SHE NOTICED HER FILE

THE INFORMATION BELOW IS CONFIDENTIAL - FOR USE BY AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY

CABINET HAD BEEN OPENED. SHE LOOKED INTO THE BOTTOM DRAWER OF THE FILE CABINET AND NOTICED A WHITE ENVELOPE WITH APPROXIMATELY \$300 USC IN MISCELLANEOUS BILLS WAS MISSING. A SECOND BANK OF AMERICA ENVELOPE WITH APPROXIMATELY \$100 USC WAS MISSING AS WELL. SHE ALSO NOTICED THREE JEWELRY BOXES THAT SHE KEPT IN THE DRAWER HAD BEEN EMPTIED. ONE OF THE BOXES CONTAINED AN OLDER STYLE GOLD RING WITH 9 OR 10 DIAMONDS IN A CLUSTER. THE SECOND BOX CONTAINED TWO OPAL RINGS WITH THIN GOLD BANDS. THE OPALS ON THE RINGS WERE APPROXIMATELY PEA SIZED. SHE WAS UNSURE WHAT HAD BEEN IN THE THIRD BOX. HER KOHL'S CHARGE CARD, WHICH HAD BEEN ON TOP OF HER DRESSER, WAS MISSING.

INSIDE OF [REDACTED] RECENTLY DECEASED MOTHER'S ROOM, THE TOP DRAWER WAS OPEN AND HAD BEEN GONE THROUGH. [REDACTED] WAS UNSURE IF ANYTHING HAD BEEN TAKEN FROM THE DRAWER. [REDACTED] BELIEVED THE SECOND MALE IN THE VEHICLE HAD ENTERED HER APARTMENT WHILE THE HEAVYSET MALE DISTRACTED HER.

I NOTIFIED CMDR BUSCH WHO ADVISED THE EPPD DESK TO CONTACT THE ON CALL EVIDENCE TECHNICIAN, OFC MARCHI. AUX OFC ROBLES ARRIVED ON SCENE TO AWAIT OFC MARCHI'S ARRIVAL.

[REDACTED] LATER NOTIFIED ME THREE ADDITIONAL RINGS HAD BEEN TAKEN FROM THE JEWELRY BOX ON TOP OF HER DRESSER. SHE DESCRIBED THEM AS:  
 -A BLUE PEAR SHAPED TOPAZ RING WITH WHITE TOPAZ ON THE SIDE  
 -A GOLD RING WITH CHANNEL SET RUBIES  
 -A 14K GOLD RING WITH A JADE ELEPHANT HEAD THAT HAD GOLD TUSKS

I PROVIDED [REDACTED] WITH AN EPPD SUPPLEMENTAL PROPERTY SHEET. AUX OFC ROBLES STOOD BY UNTIL OFC MARCHI ARRIVED TO PROCESS THE SCENE. SEE ET REPORT.
