On June 30, 2016, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(a) of FOIA provides that, "[i]nformation specifically prohibited from disclosure by federal or State law or rules and regulations implementing federal or State law" is exempt from disclosure. Section 1240.80(d) of Title 20, entitled "Corrections, Criminal Justice, and Law Enforcement," of the Illinois Administrative Code provides that, "LEADS data shall not be disseminated to any individual or organization that is not legally authorized to have access to the information." Consequently, information obtained through the Law Enforcement Agencies Data System ("LEADS") has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that “private information” is exempt from disclosure. “Private information” is defined in FOIA as, “unique identifiers, including a person’s social security number, driver’s license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person.” 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including home or personal telephone numbers, and home addresses, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, “[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy” is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim’s name and identifying information, the name of a suspect who was never arrested, the names of third parties who incidentally appear in police reports, and the races of individuals, have been redacted from the records being provided.

On 06/18/2016 at 2206 hours, I responded to the Elmwood Park Police Department lobby reference criminal sexual assault.

Upon arrival I spoke to [REDACTED] (f [REDACTED] who told me the following in summary:

[REDACTED] has residential custody of her daughter [REDACTED] (f [REDACTED] father [REDACTED] (m [REDACTED] resides in Colorado and has court ordered visitation. [REDACTED] had visited her father every year with the exception of 2014 and usually spends 4-5 weeks there. She also visits more sporadically in spring and winter.

In 2007 [REDACTED] was in daycare and began acting strangely. [REDACTED] was asking other children to touch her in her private areas. Observing this behavior, [REDACTED] teacher contacted [REDACTED] and reported the behavior. [REDACTED] had [REDACTED] see a therapist and filed a police report with the Elmwood Park Police Department through Ofc Zelasco. (Original RD# Unknown) [REDACTED] did not do well in therapy and discontinued going. The offender was never located.

Since the winter visit in 2013, where she was gone for 2 weeks, [REDACTED] has been very vocal about not wanting to go to her father's residence for visits, to the extent that she has threatened to harm herself if forced to go.

Due to [REDACTED] hesitation of visiting her father, [REDACTED] has had [REDACTED] seeing her old therapist, [REDACTED] for the last three years. It was through this therapy that [REDACTED] learned [REDACTED] has been both physically and emotionally abusing [REDACTED] has witnessed violent fights during her visits between [REDACTED] and his new wife, some fights involving weapons. [REDACTED] has been witness to and involved in sexually explicit conversations with [REDACTED]. During her visits, [REDACTED] doesn't allow [REDACTED] to communicate with [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] last visit was in spring of 2016. During this visit [REDACTED] learned [REDACTED] half-brothers, aged around 8 years old, were inappropriately touching [REDACTED] breasts. When [REDACTED] told her father of the incident, her father did not correct the behavior and only laughed about what happened. Since this time, [REDACTED] has begun to lose interest in school and her grades began to drop. [REDACTED] was alerted to this by [REDACTED] teacher, [REDACTED] at Elm Middle School. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that [REDACTED] has been acting different since spring break.

[REDACTED] was not sure therapy was working and acted on the advice of one of her friends. [REDACTED] reached out to Sarah's Inn and was assigned a case worker named Francesca's. On Tuesday 06/14/2016 [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] went to visit the caseworker and had a productive conversation.

[REDACTED] is scheduled for her summer visit to her father and is set to leave on 06/19/2016 at approximately 6AM. On 06/18/2016 at approximately noon, [REDACTED] reached out to Francesca via text message and out cried allegations that the sexual assault in 2007 was committed by her father [REDACTED]. Francesca advised [REDACTED] to tell her mother about the incident and she did.

[REDACTED] was unsure what to do with the new information and eventually decided to come to the police station
