Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including social security numbers, driver's license numbers, home or personal telephone numbers, home address, and signatures, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying

Action Taken

The following is a summary of my actions relative to the investigation of a reported domestic battery that occurred on or about 6-8-11 at 7201 W. Grand Avenue, Elmwood Park, Cook County, Illinois, 60707. Any witnesses and/or suspect statements contained herein are not in their entirety nor verbatim.

On 6-9-11 I contacted the victim [REDACTED] via telephone. I reviewed [REDACTED] case report with her. [REDACTED] related to me the sequence of events as it was documented in her original offense report.
