Re: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Ms. Mleczek:

On March 21, 2016, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"Record of Arrest: Michael Mleczek
Aug/Sept 2013 2535 W. Belden
Labor day weekend Chicago, IL 60647[.]"

Certified copies of the records responsive to your FOIA request are available for pickup at the Village of Elmwood Park Village Hall, 11 Conti Parkway, Elmwood Park, Illinois 60707. Pursuant to Section 6(b) of FOIA, the Village of Elmwood Park charges One (\$1.00) Dollar for certifying documents. Therefore, when you pick up the records responsive to your FOIA request, please remit payment to the Village of Elmwood Park in the amount of One (\$1.00) Dollar. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled

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without possibility of attribution to any person.” 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including driver’s license numbers, home or personal telephone numbers, home addresses, and signatures, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, “[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy” is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim’s name and identifying information, the names of third-parties who incidentally appear in police reports, and the races of individuals, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(d)(iv) of FOIA provides that, “[r]ecords in the possession of any public body created in the course of administrative enforcement proceedings, and any law enforcement or correctional agency for law enforcement purposes” are exempt from disclosure, “but only to the extent that disclosure would: ... unavoidably disclose the identity of a confidential source, confidential information furnished only by the confidential source, or persons who file complaints with or provide information to administrative, investigative, law enforcement, or penal agencies.” Consequently, information that would reveal the identity of persons who filed complaints with or provided information to the Village of Elmwood Park Police Department has been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General’s Office. 




I observed multiple subjects standing on the porch area of the residence who were involved in the incident. I spoke to [REDACTED], m [REDACTED], who told me the following in summary:

[REDACTED] said on 08/30/13, he has been receiving numerous telephone calls from his brother Michael about their mother's residence. [REDACTED] said his mother recently passed away and he has power of attorney over his mother's assets. He said Michael is upset at him because he has control over her estate. He said Michael continued to call him asking if he can go to their mother's house to look in a safe which was on the property. He said he continued to tell Michael he did not want to discuss the matter and Michael wanted to come to his residence to talk. He said he advised Michael he did not want him around his residence and hung up the telephone. He said Michael continued to call advising he was going to come over to his house and "kick his ass." [REDACTED] said he advised Michael again to not come over to the residence.

[REDACTED] said at approximately 1840 hours, Michael rang his door bell and demanded to come inside his residence. [REDACTED] said he opened the door and observed Michael was intoxicated. He said he told Michael to leave his residence and Michael continued to try to come into his residence because he wanted to talk. He said he went outside to prevent Michael from coming into his house and Michael started to physically fight with him by striking him with closed fists. He said his son-in-law [REDACTED] m [REDACTED], heard the fight occurring and assisted him with controlling Michael. He said he and [REDACTED] held Michael to the ground until the police arrived. He said his daughter [REDACTED] f [REDACTED], called the police.






[redacted] said he did not require medical treatment. I did not observe any visible signs of injury or harm on [redacted] or [redacted].

Officer Barrile transported Michael to the Elmwood Park Police station. Upon my arrival, I processed Michael with all the necessary prisoner screening forms. I fingerprinted Michael for identification purposes. I advised Michael his constitutional rights per Miranda in which he waived and gave a statement freely. (See statement sheet). While speaking with Michael, I detected a strong odor of an alcohol based beverage emitting from his breath. Michael was placed into cell #B3 to wait for further processing.

Officer Barrile inventoried Michael's property into the BEAST system for safe-keeping. Officer Barrile fingerprinted, photographed, and processed Michael according to Elmwood Park Police procedures. Michael was advised of his court information, given a copy of his criminal complaint, and prepared for bond court.

[REDACTED] told me Michael was his brother and he came to his house drunk and was out of control. He told me he wanted Michael arrested.


[REDACTED] told me Michael was out of control and was going after [REDACTED] so he put him into a head lock to control him.


