On March 7, 2016, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"I am requesting a report of my 911 Tape that I made to Elmwood Park Police on July 20, 1996 in early morning for legal purposes."

The records responsive to your FOIA request consist of sixty-four (64) pages of black and white letter sized copies and a CD-ROM containing a 911 call. Please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that “private information” is exempt from disclosure. “Private information” is defined in FOIA as, “unique identifiers, including a person’s social security number, driver’s license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person.” 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including social security numbers, driver’s license numbers, home or personal telephone numbers, home addresses, and signatures, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, “[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy” is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including the races of individuals, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(d)(iv) of FOIA provides that, “[r]ecords in the possession of any public body created in the course of administrative enforcement proceedings, and any law enforcement or correctional agency for law enforcement purposes” are exempt from disclosure, “but only to the extent that disclosure would: ... unavoidably disclose the identity of a confidential source, confidential information furnished only by the confidential source, or persons who file complaints with or provide information to administrative, investigative, law enforcement, or penal agencies.” Consequently, information that would reveal the identity of persons who filed complaints with or provided information to the Village of Elmwood Park Police Department has been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. [REDACTED] was not sure who asked her this, but she advised them she did not know if they could get any money from this debt consolidation loan. [REDACTED] said that ended the conversation of them getting any cash from the loan.

[REDACTED] also stated the loan was approved, and she believes the closing was on 15 July 1996. [REDACTED] did not have the title company file, but believes the Greater Illinois Title Co. out of Westchester, Il., tx. 449-6919 is the title company assigned to handle the closing. The closing was done at St. Paul Federal Bank and the title company disbursed the funds on the loan. Again [REDACTED] said she did not know how the loan was disbursed and what companies received what funds, only that the loan was for \$17,700.00 for ten years.

I/O asked [REDACTED] if either Mr. or Mrs. Menotti had taken out any insurance policies with the loan. [REDACTED] stated both had applied for term insurance, but Mr. Menotti was turned down because of his age. [REDACTED] was not sure if Mrs. Menotti was approved, that would have been done through the title company. Again [REDACTED] did not have that information, only that the term insurance would have been for the amount of the loan.

I/O asked [REDACTED] why the Menotti's came to St. Paul Federal Bank to get a loan. [REDACTED] said the Menotti's had other accounts at St. Paul, but she would not elaborate on that issue.

I/O then asked [REDACTED] how the Menotti's were when they came in for the loan. [REDACTED] said they both were very considerate with each other, when answering questions, they would both agree on the answer. They never had any problems while they were there, they seemed to be very family oriented. Mrs. Menotti did most of the inquiring as to the loan, almost like it appeared she handled the bills at home. They always came in together and both signed for the loan.

I/O asked [REDACTED] if there was anything else she could think of that might be of importance in this matter. Only that St. Paul Federal Bank has put a lien on the Menotti condominium, and that Mr. Menotti's brother contacted her advising that he would not be able to make the payments on the loan. [REDACTED] could not give or let I/O see any documents pertaining to this loan, nor could she retrieve the actual closing and title company information.
