Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, “[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy” is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including victims’ names and identifying information, the names of suspects who were never arrested, the names of third parties who incidentally appear in police reports, and the races of individuals, have been redacted from the records being provided.





Bart and [REDACTED] was in the room and witnessed the battery. [REDACTED] began to cry. Bart left the house in their Honda Odyssey, IL REG # [REDACTED] [REDACTED] called the police. [REDACTED] said Bart has beaten her approximately 4 years ago. [REDACTED] said she does not want Bart arrested for the battery. [REDACTED] said she believes Bart is having trouble at work.
