Re: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Mr. Badillo:

On May 9, 2016, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for "16-1011[.]"

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including a home or personal telephone number, and a home address, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy,

including a victim's name and identifying information, and the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General's Office. If you choose to file a Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor, you must do so within 60 calendar days of the date of this letter. Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this letter when filing a Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor.

You are also notified that you have the right to judicial review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer pursuant to Section 11 of FOIA.

On 05/03/2016, at approximately 1120 hrs, I spoke with ██████████ (M ██████████) at the police department regarding a possible package theft.

██████████ said he ordered a graphics card (NVidia GTX970; \$359.99) from Newegg.com. The graphics card shipped via FedEx on 03/28/2016. ██████████ noticed the package had not arrived after waiting several weeks and checked the package tracking number, observing the package was reported delivered on 03/29/2016 at approximately 1300 hrs. He called FedEx who advised the package was left at the rear entrance of his building on that date and time.

██████████ advised his building does not have security cameras, and did not recall suspicious activity in the area around the timeframe of occurrence.

██████████ said he did not want the incident investigated further and only wished to make a report.

I gave ██████████ the Illinois Crime Victim Notification form with his report number, and advised him to call police if he observes suspicious activity in the future.
