Re: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Ms. O'Toole:

On November 2, 2016, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for "16-2234[.]"

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including home or personal telephone numbers, and home addresses, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including the races of individuals, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(d)(iv) of FOIA provides that, "[r]ecords in the possession of any public body created in the course of administrative enforcement proceedings, and any law enforcement or correctional agency for law enforcement purposes" are exempt from disclosure, "but only to the extent that disclosure would:

... unavoidably disclose the identity of a confidential source, confidential information furnished only by the confidential source, or persons who file complaints with or provide information to administrative, investigative, law enforcement, or penal agencies." Consequently, information that would reveal the identity of persons who filed complaints with or provided information to the Village of Elmwood Park Police Department has been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General's Office. If you choose to file a Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor, you must do so within 60 calendar days of the date of this letter. Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this letter when filing a Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor.

You are also notified that you have the right to judicial review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer pursuant to Section 11 of FOIA.

ON THE GIVEN DATE 9/11/2016, DEBRA OTOOLE CALLED POLICE TO REPORT NUMEROUS ELECTRONIC ITEMS TAKEN FROM HER RESIDENCE SHE SHARES WITH HER BOYFRIEND [REDACTED] AT [REDACTED]

DEBRA STATED SHE HAD LEFT THE RESIDENCE ON 09/09/2016, AT 1500 HOURS, TO VISIT HER DAUGHTER IN CHICAGO. [REDACTED] STATED HER BOYFRIEND [REDACTED] WAS HOME AND USING DRUGS.

[REDACTED] HAD BEEN IN RESIDENCE PRIOR TO INCIDENT AND LATER ARRESTED BY THIS AGENCY IN THE REAR ALLEY AFTER DEBRA HAD STATED SHE HAD LEFT TO VISIT FAMILY. [REDACTED] WAS ALSO WITH ANOTHER SUBJECT WHO WAS STOPPED BY OFFICERS OUTSIDE THE RESIDENCE ON 09/09/2016.

DEBRA STATED SHE RETURNED HOME ON 09/11/2016, AT 1600 HOURS AND WAS ADVISED BY NEIGHBOR [REDACTED] THAT THE REAR DOOR WINDOW OF HER APARTMENT WAS BROKEN.

DEBRA STATED THREE (3) SONY PLAY STATION 3 GAMING SYSTEMS WERE TAKEN FROM HER BEDROOM AND A FLAT SCREEN TV WAS TAKEN OFF THE KITCHEN WALL. DEBRA DOES NOT KNOW VALUES, MAKE, MODEL, SIZE OR SERIAL NUMBERS OF ITEMS TAKEN.

I DID NOTICE A FLAT SCREEN TV, SONY PLAY STATION, WIRELESS REMOTE CONTROLS FOR PLAY STATION, NUMEROUS VIDEO GAMES, CLOTHES GARBAGE ON FLOORS AND TABLES INSIDE HER APARTMENT.

DEBRA STATED SHE DID NOT THINK ANYONE IN THE BUILDING COULD HAVE TAKEN ITEMS BECAUSE THE RESIDENTS ARE ALL GOOD PEOPLE. DEBRA DID NOT THINK SHE HAD ANY INSURANCE TO COVER THEFT AND WOULD BE CONTACTING BUILDING OWNER TO ADVISE HIM OF BROKEN WINDOW.
