Re: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Mr. Cancel:

On November 18, 2016, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for "16-2775[.]"

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including home or personal telephone numbers, and home addresses, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, the name of a third party who incidentally appears in a police report, and the races of individuals, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(d)(iv) of FOIA provides that, "[r]ecords in the possession of any public body created in the course of administrative enforcement proceedings, and any law enforcement or correctional agency

for law enforcement purposes” are exempt from disclosure, “but only to the extent that disclosure would: ... unavoidably disclose the identity of a confidential source, confidential information furnished only by the confidential source, or persons who file complaints with or provide information to administrative, investigative, law enforcement, or penal agencies.” Consequently, information that would reveal the identity of persons who filed complaints with or provided information to the Village of Elmwood Park Police Department has been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General’s Office. You are also notified that you have the right to judicial review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer pursuant to Section 11 of FOIA.

On 11/11/2016 at approximately 0515 hours I spoke with [REDACTED] (M. [REDACTED]) at the Public Safety Building regarding his son [REDACTED] being bite by his ex-girlfriends current girlfriends dog.

The following was my conversation with [REDACTED] in summary.

[REDACTED] said he received a call from his ex-girlfriend, [REDACTED] (F. [REDACTED]) who informed him [REDACTED] was bitten by a dog. [REDACTED] said they took [REDACTED] to Luries Children`s Hospital, where he was treated and released. [REDACTED] said the bite from the dog broke [REDACTED] skin.

I relocated to [REDACTED] residence at [REDACTED]

The following is my conversation with [REDACTED] in summary.

[REDACTED] stated the dog belongs to her girlfriend, who she identified as [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] was playing with the dog when he grabbed the dog by the tail. The dog then turned around and bite [REDACTED] in the arm, causing a small puncture. [REDACTED] said she then took [REDACTED] to the Hospital, where he was treated and released. [REDACTED] said the dog is no longer at the residence, due to the incident. [REDACTED] said [REDACTED] stays at her residence sometimes, and is not her permanent residence.

I gave [REDACTED] her copy of the Animal Bite Card and explained to her she must comply with the instructions on the card. [REDACTED] said she will contact [REDACTED] and comply with the instructions.

I completed an Animal Bite Card, which was sent to Cook County Animal and Rabies Control.
