**Re: Freedom of Information Act Request**

Dear Ms. Reyes:

On October 3, 2016, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for "RD #16-2313[.]"

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, a home address has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

While on patrol, 09/21/16, at 0233 hours, traveling northbound on the 2400 block of 78th Avenue and crossing Altgeld Avenue, I saw two subjects walking eastbound on the south sidewalk of Altgeld Avenue, between 78th Court and 78th Avenue.

Subject #1 - M/H, 18-22, 506, medium build, black roman cut hair, thin moustache, small goatee, black hoodie, black shorts, black gym shoes.

Subject #2 - M/H, 509-600, thin build, black hoodie, gray or light colored shorts, black gym shoes.

Upon seeing me and the squad, both subjects put turned around and began walking westbound. I drove to Grand Avenue, went west to 78th Court, and south on 78th Court back to Altgeld Avenue, intending to locate the two subjects, stop them, and speak to them. When I arrived at the intersection of 78th Court and Altgeld Avenue, I did not see the two subjects walking in the area. I drove to the southeast corner of 78th Court and Altgeld Avenue, stopped to look along the sidewalk for the two subjects, and stopped my squad. I still did not see the two subjects in the area.

I noticed a white Honda (IL#Q508519) parked in front of 2439 78th Court. The two passenger side wheels were missing. The car was set on top of three cinder blocks, and a gray jack. Lug nuts were lying in the street near the missing wheels.

I exited my squad checked the Honda closely, and saw no other damage or items missing.

I walked back to my squad, and began to notify WESCOM of the apparent Theft. As I was calling in the location and theft, I walked eastbound on the sidewalk, looking for the two subjects that I had originally observed walking away from the area of the Theft, I saw the same two subjects run out from between cars parked on the south side of Altgeld Avenue, headed northbound on 78th Avenue.

I requested WESCOM send additional officers to the area to search for the subjects running northbound on 78th Avenue.

I ran to the intersection of 78th Avenue and Altgeld Avenue, and did not see the subjects anywhere.

Officers Borrini, Pavone, and Loni arrived in the area.

I returned to the Honda.

I photographed the Honda, put on rubber gloves, and collected the lug nuts as evidence. I was unable to remove the jack from under the Honda and collect it as evidence.

I attempted to make contact with the owner of the Honda, Elizabeth Reyes (f [REDACTED]) at [REDACTED], but was unable to make contact with her.

I searched the area with Borrini, Pavone, and Loni, but the two subjects could not be found.

I returned to EPPD to complete the report.

CSO Saldana was able to find a phone number for Reyes. He made contact with her on the phone, and gave her the report number. He told Reyes to contact the police when the missing vehicle tires are replaced, so the jack can be collected as evidence.

Reyes advised she would not touch the jack, and would contact the police as soon as the Honda was ready to be lifted up off of the jack and cinder blocks.

No further information at this time.
