RE: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Ms. Pincher,

The Village of Elmwood Park is in receipt of your October 18, 2016, Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 et seq.) ("FOIA") for the following records:

"16-2235"

Enclosed are copies of the records you requested. However, please be advised that certain information in the records being provided has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA, and that information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee id number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses." Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "personal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, such as the victim's name and identifying information, have been redacted from the records being provided.

In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General's Office.

Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this letter when filing a Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor. You are also notified that you have the right to judicial review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer pursuant to Section II of FOIA.

On 09/11/2016, at approximately 1802 hours, Sergeant Brown, Officer Brand and I were dispatched to a Domestic Disturbance at 7819 72nd ct.

Upon arrival the caller Irena Pinscher (F/W, 1... opened the side gate to the backyard and invited us in. Irena said her roommate Ireneusz Kaminski (M/W ... had been drinking and destroyed the place.

I spoke with Ireneusz who stated the following in summary;

He had returned home approximately two hours ago. A short time after returning home he began cooking dinner when Irena got upset that he was using her table. He began having a verbal argument with Irena. During the verbal argument he said Irena pushed him twice. After Irena pushed him the second time he pushed her back. After he pushed her, Irena hit him in on the back.

While speaking with Ireneusz I could detect an odor of an alcoholic beverage coming from his breath.

Sergeant Brown spoke with Irena. Irena told Sergeant Brown that Ireneusz was drinking and began breaking things in the residence. Irena said they began arguing, during the argument Ireneusz took a knife from the kitchen and started scraping it on the kitchen counter saying "you see." After this she called the police.

Sergeant Brown, who went inside the residence with Irena, said there were objects inside the residence that had been broken.

There were no visible signs of physical injury on either Irena or Ireneusz at this time.

Irena decided it was best if she was to leave and stay at her friends. Irena left without incident.
