Dear Mr. Reynolds:

On September 21, 2016, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"15-4274
16-2289[.]"

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including home or personal telephone numbers, home addresses, and a signature, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal

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privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including the name of a suspect who was never arrested, the name of a third party who incidentally appears in a police report, and the races of individuals, have been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General's Office. On 09/18/16, at about 1215 hours, I responded to 37 W. Conti Plkwy for a damage to property report.

Upon arrival, I met with James Reynolds (agent for management company). James told me in summary: Sometime in the last 24 hours, an unknown person damaged the screen door by forcefully opening it causing the screen door closer to break off from the wood doorway. The door closer was observed by James in the bushes next to the door. Screws were placed on the corner of the doorway step and did not appear to land there by chance. James did not think the door was forced open from wind. James suspected that resident [REDACTED] is responsible because of problems in the past. James said [REDACTED] has damaged parts of the building in the past and complained about the damages to the condo association. [REDACTED] is 4 months past due on her association fees. James wanted documentation of the incident to forward to [REDACTED] (manager).
