On October 14, 2016, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for "16-2479[.]"

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including a driver's license number, a home or personal telephone number, and home addresses, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy,

On 10/09/2016 at approximately 1541 hours, I was dispatched to the EPPD lobby for a domestic battery which occurred on 10/06/2016 around 1700 hours.

Upon arrival, I spoke with the victim, Nancy L Demas f [REDACTED] who stated on 10/06/2016 at approximately 1700 hours she was cleaning her car, which was parked on the street in front of her house. She stated her ex boyfriend, [REDACTED] m [REDACTED] came out of his residence, [REDACTED], and began speaking to Nancy. Nancy told him to leave her alone and their relationship was over. He then came down to her and grabbed her left arm at the elbow. She then began crying because of the pain he was causing her and he said, "What are you crying for? Do you want some Norco?" She refused and he then went back into his residence.

She did not report the incident at the time it happened because she did not see a bruise immediately. She noticed the bruise today and she came in to report the incident. She originally went to Chicago and was advised to speak to the Elmwood Park police since the incident happened in Elmwood Park.

I observed two large bruises on the inside of her left arm around the elbow. I took pictures of the injured area and asked her if she would like to see the paramedics. She refused medical attention. See attached photos.

Nancy stated she did not want [REDACTED] arrested she only wanted to document the incident so she can seek a restraining order against him. She stated she knew how to obtain the document. Nancy was provided a copy of the Crime Victim's Notification and the report number. She was also advised to contact the police immediately if [REDACTED] makes any further contact with her.
