**Re: Freedom of Information Act Request**

Dear Mr. Reynolds:

On September 13, 2016, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for "Report # 16-01829[.]"

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including a home or personal telephone number, and a home address, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.



On 07-27-2016 I responded to 37 Conti Pkwy on a burglary. Upon my arrival I spoke with James Reynolds. James stated between 07-24-2016 and 07-27-2016 unknown offender/s entered the basement laundry room damaged the coin lock box on the Whirlpool washing machine. Entered the coin lock box on the Maytag washing machine and took between \$50.00 usc and \$70.00 usc. James related thats the average money in a month. James also stated the inside door of the laundry room was damaged. That door was accidentally locked which is suppose to be left unlocked for tenants.
