Re: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Mr. Martorana:

On September 12, 2016, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"Pursuant to the Freedom of Information Act, I hereby request any and all documents, including the police report with description of the incident and offenders, relating to an armed robbery that allegedly occurred in September, 2016 at Game Stop located at Elmwood Commons, 1710 N Harlem Ave, STE C, Elmwood Park, IL 60707."

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including home or personal telephone numbers, and home addresses, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, and the races of individuals, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(d)(iv) of FOIA provides that, “[r]ecords in the possession of any public body created in the course of administrative enforcement proceedings, and any law enforcement or correctional agency for law enforcement purposes” are exempt from disclosure, “but only to the extent that disclosure would: ... unavoidably disclose the identity of a confidential source, confidential information furnished only by the confidential source, or persons who file complaints with or provide information to administrative, investigative, law enforcement, or penal agencies.” Consequently, information that would reveal the identity of persons who filed complaints with or provided information to the Village of Elmwood Park Police Department has been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. You are also notified that you have the right to judicial review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer pursuant to Section 11 of FOIA.

On 09-03-2016 at 1245 hours, Commander Kmiecik and I were dispatched to 1710 Harlem Av {Game Stop} for a report of an armed robbery. Upon our arrival, we entered the business. The manager of the business, [REDACTED] and a customer, [REDACTED] were the only two persons in the business. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] told me there were 2 male black offenders. [REDACTED] told me both offenders were about 507 and had thin builds. One offender had a red cap and wore a black hoody. The second offender had a grey hoody and a silver semi-automatic gun. As per Commander Kmiecik, I contacted ISPERN dispatch and informed them of the incident, ISPERN # 2874. Sgt Rosa and Ofc Schak conducted a canvas of the businesses and residences in the area. Commander Kmiecik interviewed [REDACTED]. (see Commander Kmiecik's supplemental report) [REDACTED] contacted his manager to retrieve video surveillance.

[REDACTED] told me he was behind the counter helping [REDACTED] with a return. At that time 2 male blacks described above walked into the business and walked up toward the counter behind [REDACTED]. One male with a grey long sleeve sweater [REDACTED] wasn't sure if it was a hoody) asked the price of a game and [REDACTED] responded about \$100.00 dollars. [REDACTED] related the two offenders looked at each other. The offender wearing grey pulled out a silver semi-automatic gun and pointed it at [REDACTED]. The offender wearing grey stated "Where's the money?" and told [REDACTED] to open the safe. [REDACTED] told me [REDACTED] was pushed behind the counter and pushed to the floor. [REDACTED] told the offenders it would take time to open the safe. The offender wearing grey held the gun toward [REDACTED] while the other offender took an unknown amount of money from the register. The offender in the black hoody took [REDACTED] money from his wallet and both offenders fled the business through the front door. The scene was turned over to Detective commander Klisz.

On 09/03/16 at 1245 hours, I responded to an Armed Robbery at 1708 Harlem Av, Gamestop.

Upon arrival, Commander Kmiecik #1312 instructed me to canvass the area.

I spoke with [REDACTED] (F [REDACTED] at the corner of 72nd Ct/Wabansia Av. [REDACTED] stated she was walking her dog when she observed two (2) subjects walking westbound Wabansia Av on the north side of the street. The subjects were walking quickly and covering their faces. [REDACTED] dog began to bark at the subjects. The subjects then started running westbound Wabansia Av from 72nd Ct on the north side of the street. [REDACTED] observed the subjects get into a vehicle which was parked on 73rd Av just north of Wabansia Av. The vehicle fled northbound 73rd Av and then eastbound Bloomingdale Av.

[REDACTED] described the first subject as M/B, 6'00", thin, scruffy beard, wearing a white shirt and jeans. [REDACTED] described the second subject as M/B, 6'00", thin, short hair with curls, wearing dark shirt and baggy white jeans. [REDACTED] described the vehicle as a newer champagne silver Chevrolet Malibu. The vehicle had temporary registration.

I advised ISPERN of the vehicle description and direction of travel.

[REDACTED] believes the resident, [REDACTED] at [REDACTED] has cameras on her property which cover the sidewalk. I was unable to make immediate contact with Judy.

On 03 Sep 2016, I responded to a report of an armed robbery at Gamestop. I requested neighboring jurisdictions be notified of the incident. Upon arrival with Ofc Marino we located the two victims, [redacted] and [redacted]. Both refused medical attention. I secured the area with crime scene tape to preserve any evidence and informed [redacted] not to tamper with anything that may be of evidentiary value. [redacted] informed me one of the offenders touched her cellular telephone. The cellular telephone was secured on top of a display case and transported by myself to the police station for processing by Evidence Technician Ofc. Brand. I made the proper notifications and requested an evidence technician respond. Assisting officers conducted a canvass (see related supplemental reports).

I spoke with the manager of the T Mobile store, [redacted] who told me his surveillance cameras secured video of the armed robbery offenders as the two moved in front of the store. [redacted] also told me he had a picture of the males in front of the T Mobile store. [redacted] showed me the photo on his cellular telephone and I requested he email it to me. I also requested video be secured for evidence. Upon arrival of Inv Commander Klisz, I spoke with [redacted] as she sat in the rear of my vehicle in the lot.

[redacted] told me she visited the Gamestop store and stood at the register with the clerk, now known to be [redacted]. [redacted] held her cellular telephone in her hand. [redacted] heard the clerk greet someone. Two males described as:

* approx 20 - 25 yoa black male, 507/508 medium build, grey hoodie, greyish black jeans

* approx 20-25 yoa male black same height and build, blk hoodie

approached from behind and stood in close proximity to her. [redacted] heard one of the males comment they were committing a robbery. One of the males ordered [redacted] to put her cellular telephone down. He grabbed it out of her hand and placed it on the counter. The male told [redacted] to move behind the counter as he held a handgun she described as a silver in color flat indicating a semi-automatic. The male pushed [redacted] to the area at the entrance of the rear behind the counter and to the ground as he pointed the gun at her back. The male took custody of her purse from her shoulder and [redacted] believed removed approximately \$15.00 USC from it. The second male offender stood behind the counter and ordered the clerk, [redacted] to open the safe. [redacted] explained it would take time for the safe to open. [redacted] heard the male holding the gun make a noise with it caused by some type of action [redacted] believed was not a trigger pull. [redacted] heard [redacted] say he had money in his wallet. The second male offender removed [redacted] wallet from his pants. [redacted] heard one of the males state they needed to go and both male offenders fled the store.

I received information via radio the Gamestop in Melrose Park had been robbed subsequent to the Elmwood Park store. I requested WSCDC contact Northlake police department and inform them of the armed robberies.

I received information River Grove police officers had contact with possible suspects. I transported [redacted] to the area of Grand and Thatcher (Forest Security parking lot) where a show up of a vehicle and two males was conducted with negative results.

The following are my actions as an evidence technician in the reported armed robbery at 1710 Harlem Av.

I photographed the scene as it was. I spoke to employees on scene who showed me video footage of the offense. I spoke to employee [REDACTED] who explained to me a summary of what happened and what places the offender's touched so I may attempt to locate fingerprints.

I put on a new pair of latex gloves. I applied a black dusting powder to a gray counter where one of the offenders placed his hand to climb over. I located several areas which appeared to reveal fingerprints. Due to the porous surface of the counter, I was unable to properly pull and secure any fingerprints for evidence.

I applied a white dusting powder on a black cash register drawer which was touched by one of the offenders. I located several visible fingerprints on each side of the register. I used a hingelifter to secure the fingerprints as evidence.

Cmdr Klisz secured a DVD showing video footage of the offense.

Ofc Dressner collected elimination fingerprints from the employees on scene. We placed collected items into our inventory system pending a laboratory submission.

No further action taken.

On 09-03-16, I responded to 1708 N. Harlem Avenue, Game Stop, for a reported armed robbery.

Upon arrival I spoke to Commander Kmiecik who gave me a briefing on the incident.

I spoke to store clerk [REDACTED], Mr [REDACTED] who told me the following in summary, this statement is not verbatim or in its entirety:

[REDACTED] said he was at the counter helping a costumer, now known as [REDACTED]. He said two (2) male blacks came into the store. He described them as suspect #1 male black, 20-25 years of age, 507-508 tall, medium to thin built, black hair, brown eyes, wearing a black t-shirt and possibly jeans. He described suspect #2 as a male black, 20-25 years of age, 507-508 tall, brown eyes, medium to thin built and wearing a gray hoody with a red baseball cap. He said the suspects walked up to the counter and asked the price of a game station. He said suspect #1 then pulled out a silver colored gun and forced [REDACTED] to the ground behind the counter. He said suspect #2 jumped over the counter. He said suspect #2 was telling him to open the drawer and was asking where the money was. He said suspect #1 told him to open the safe. He said he told them it would take 9 minutes to open the safe. He said suspect #1 racked the gun. He said suspect #2 was going through the register drawer. He said suspect #2 then took his wallet and \$20.00 USC. He said suspect #1 was touching the register drawer. He said then one of them said "we gone", and left running out of the store. He said he called the police.

[REDACTED] told me he would be able to identify the suspect if seen again.

I spoke to [REDACTED], from Jimmy Johns, [REDACTED]. He told me he saw two (2) male blacks run past the front of his store. He gave the same description as [REDACTED]

I contacted [REDACTED], 708-771-7600 of Bern Realty, property management company, and requested he preserve the video surveillance from outside the Game Stop.

I obtained video surveillance from the Game Stop security system and Game Stop employees. They turned over 2 discs for evidence.

I returned to the Elmwood Park Police Station and created a Trak Flyer and sent it out to receiving agencies.
