Re: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Mr. Koval:

On September 19, 2016, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"I need a copy of my police report I filed
Police report was filed at the end of August 2016[.]"

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including a home or personal telephone number, and a home address, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal

privacy” is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General’s Office. You can file your Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor by writing to:



On 08-22-16 I spoke to Vasyi Koval at the Elmwood Park Police Station.

Vasyi told me he ordered an Apple Macbook Pro laptop Computer through Amazon.com. Vasyi said according to the shipping information for the laptop, tracking #9611 8042 4094 6434 9538 56", the computer was delivered on 08-13-16 at "1pm". Vasyi said the shipping information said "package was left on an outside porch". Vasyi said he never received the package.

Vasyi said he arrived home at about 1600 hours and never saw the package. Vasyi contacted Amazon to make a claim for the missing computer. He said their records show the package was delivered.

Vasyi said he does not have a serial number for the laptop because he never physically possessed it. I asked Vasyi to attempt to get the serial number from Amazon or the company he purchased the computer from via Amazon, to see if they can get him a serial number for our records.

I gave Vasyi his report number and advised him on how to get a copy of the report.
