On April 17, 2017, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 et seq.) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"17-620"

Your request has been denied.

Section 7 (1) (d) (i) of FOIA provides that, "[r]ecords in the possession of any public body created in the course of administrative enforcement proceedings, and any law enforcement or correctional agency for law enforcement purposes..." are exempt from disclosure, "but only to the extent that disclosure would....interfere with pending or actually and reasonably contemplated law enforcement proceedings conducted by any law enforcement...agency....." Consequently, information that would interfere with the pending law enforcement proceedings by the Village of Elmwood Park Police Department has been withheld. Please make a subsequent FOIA request once the investigation has been concluded.
