Dear Ms. Darlyn Perez:

On February 2, 2017, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"16-2705"

Your request has been granted in part and denied in part. Enclosed are records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records being provided has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA, and that information has been redacted from the records being provided. Furthermore, please be advised that certified copies of the records responsive to your FOIA request are available for pickup at the Village of Elmwood Park Village Hall located at 11 Conti Parkway, Elmwood Park, Illinois 60707. Pursuant to Section 6 (b) of FOIA, the Village of Elmwood Park charges \$1.00 for certifying documents. Therefore, when you pick up the documents responsive to your FOIA request, please remit payment to the Village of Elmwood Park in the amount of \$1.00.

Section 7 (1) (b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, VIN, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including employee identification numbers, home or personal telephone numbers, and home addresses, have been redacted from the records being provided.

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Section 7 (1) (c) of FOIA provides that, “[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy ...” is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, an individual’s race, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, have been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General’s Office. You can file your Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor by writing to:


