**Re: Freedom of Information Act Request**

Dear Mr. Davidson:

On February 10, 2017, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"17-261"

Your request has been granted in part and denied in part. Enclosed are records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records being provided has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA, and that information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, VIN, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including driver's license numbers, employee identification numbers, home or personal telephone numbers, and home addresses have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy ..." is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, an individual's race, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, have been redacted from the records being provided.



On 01/27/2017 at 2226 hours I responded to the police station for a lobby report of a stole motor vehicle. Upon arrival I spoke with Kevin L. Davidson who told me the following in summary:

Kevin's red 2010 Dodge Challenger was parked in the parking lot of his apartment building at [REDACTED]. He observed the vehicle there on 01/27/2017 at 0000 hours as he was bringing in groceries from his other vehicle. At approximately 0100 hours he heard a diesel engine and voices outside his bedroom window, assumed it was one of his neighbors who owns a truck, and did not look outside to investigate further. At approximately 0930 hours, he noticed his vehicle was missing. He called the police non emergency number at approximately 1000 hours and was told he would need to come in to make a report. Having to go to work, he decided he would just make the report later so he came in after work. The vehicle is financed through Edgewater Credit Union and he owes \$7000-\$8000 and he is not behind on any payments. His insurance is through State Farm and is full coverage. His mother has a spare key for the vehicle in a safe at her house but does not know how to drive. He did not observe any broken glass in the area his vehicle was parked indicative of forced entry. The only valuable property in the vehicle was an aftermarket radio that had not yet been installed. No one else drives the vehicle or has any access to it.

I told him if he locates the vehicle, either occupied or parked, call the police immediately via 911. I explained the vehicle would be entered into a database for stolen automobiles.  
 I faxed a copy of the report to WESCOM for entry into LEADS.  
 I completed my report and returned to duty.
