**Re: Freedom of Information Act Request**

Dear Mr. Soni

On February 9, 2017, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"...a copy of police report for broken on Aug 1<sup>st</sup> 2016 at 22 Conti Parkway PK Pantry Elmwood Park IL 60607"

Your request has been granted in part and denied in part. Enclosed are records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records being provided has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA, and that information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, VIN, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including names attributable to home address, employee identification numbers, home or personal telephone numbers, and home addresses have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy ..." is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, an individual's race, a victim's name and identifying information, the names of suspects who were never arrested, and other personal information, the

disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (d) (iv) of FOIA provides that, “[r]ecords in the possession of any public body created in the course of administrative enforcement proceedings, and any law enforcement or correctional agency for law enforcement purposes...” are exempt from disclosure, “but only to the extent that disclosure would...unavoidably disclose the identity of a confidential source, confidential information furnished only by the confidential source, or persons who file complaints with or provide information to administrative, investigative, law enforcement, or penal agencies...” Consequently, information that would reveal the identity of persons who have filed complaints with or who have provided information to the Village of Elmwood Park Police Department has been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General’s Office. You can file your Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor by writing to:



THE INFORMATION BELOW IS CONFIDENTIAL FOR USE BY AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY

ON 08-01-2016 AT 0557 HOURS EPPD UNITS WERE DISPATCHED TO P/K PANTRY 22 CONTI PARKWAY ELMWOOD PARK IL, FOR A BURGLAR ALARM. UNITS WERE NOTIFIED VIA RADIO TRANSMISSIONS OF THE ALARM WAS A GENERAL ACTIVATION, WITH NO SPECIFIC AREAS OF ACTIVATION.

I ARRIVED ON SCENE AT 0615 HOURS AND WAS MET BY OFFICER MICHAEL PAVONE #500 OF THE MIDNIGHT WATCH I TAPED OFF THE SCENE WITH CRIME TAPE.

PAVONE TOLD ME HE WAS THE FIRST OFFICER ON SCENE, PAVONE SAID HE APPROACHED THE FRONT OF THE BUSINESS AND SAW A SMASHED WINDOW JUST TO THE LEFT OF THE BUSINESS ENTRANCE, HE THEN CHECKED THE RIGHT DOOR OF THE BUSINESSES DOUBLE DOOR ENTRANCE AND FOUND THE DOOR OPENED / UNLOCKED. PAVONE CALLED IN HIS FINDINGS OVER HIS PORTABLE RADIO.

OFFICE CHAURIZB #1500 ARRIVED ON SCENE. PAVONE SAID THE TWO DID A COMPLETE SEARCH OF THE BUILDING'S INTERIOR AND FOUND NO ONE TO BE INSIDE.

I CHECKED THE BUSINESS WITH OFFICER PAVONE AND OBSERVED THE BROKEN GLASS WINDOW. WE ENTERED THROUGH THE OPEN DOOR AND WALKED INTO THE BUISNESS. UPON ENTERING THE BUSINESS I OBSERVED MISCELLANEOUS PRODUCTS ON THE GROUND TO THE LEFT OF THE ENTRANCE. I CONTINUED WALKING TO THE COUNTER AND SAW AN EMPTY SPACE BETWEEN LOTTERY DISPENSERS WHERE IT APPEARED A DISPENSER WAS REMOVED. WE CONTINUED TO WALK AROUND THE COUNTER TO THE FRONT OF THE COUNTER WHERE I OBSERVED THE REGISTER DRAWER ON THE GROUND. I WALKED BEHIND THE COUNTER AND SAW THE CASH REGISTER SMASHED ON THE GROUND WITH SOME US COINS AROUND IT. AS OFFICER PAVONE AND I CONTINUED TO LOOK BEHIND THE COUNTER WE SAW THREE CAMERAS IN THE GENERAL AREA OF THE COUNTER. I OBSERVED AN OPEN WOODEN DRAWER TO THE LEFT OF THE MAIN COUNTER WITH MISCELLANEOUS USC AND COINS. WE CONTINUED TO CHECK BEHIND THE COUNTER AND FOUND ROLLS OF CHANGE KEPT IN AN OLD COOLER, TWO SAFBS WERE FOUND OPEN CONTAINING A LARGE SUM OF MONEY AND EXTRA LOTTERY TICKETS. I ALSO SAW IN AN OPEN CABINET AT LEAST (5) LARGE PLASTIC CONTAINERS WITH USC COINS. ALL THE MONEY IN THE DRAWERS, SAFE, COOLER AND CABINET APPEARD TO HAVE BEEN UNTOUCHED AND UNDISTURBED.

ET MARCHI ARRIVED ON SCENE I GAVE HIM A TOUR OF THE STORE POINTING OUT KEY AREAS TO CONCENTRATE FOR PROCESSING. MARCHI TOOK PHOTOS OF THE SCENE AND ATTEMPTED TO DUST AREAS FOR ANY LATENT FINGERPRINTS. HE ALSO COLLECTED THE CASH REGISTER DRAWER FOR PROCESSING AT THE POLICE STATION. SEE ET MARCHI REPORT FOR DETAILS.

I REQUESTED ADDITIONAL OFFICERS TO THE SCENE TO ASSIST ME IN A CANVASS THE AREA FOR CAMERAS, WITNESSES AND POSSIBLE EVIDENCE. OFFICER MARINO, OFFICER ALEQUIN AND PPO DYREK ARRIVED ON SCENE TO CANVASS THE AREA.

She said around 0530 hours she heard what sounded like metal pipes striking an object and then she heard a lot of glass shattering. She stated her window was open and as soon as she heard it she looked outside. On 08/01/2016, at approximately 0630 hours, I responded to 22 Conti Pkwy for a burglary.

Upon arrival I photographed the exterior and interior of the business.

I was unable to locate and collect any forensic evidence of value.

I made the following observations:

The window to the south of the main entry doors was broken with an unknown object. Items were knocked to the floor from their places. I observed the bottom portion of the cash register on the floor in front of the main counter. I collected the bottom portion to process for finger prints. A tall display case of lottery tickets was missing from the front counter. The bottom portion of the display case was on the floor in front of the counter. Behind the counter the upper portion of the register was smashed on the floor and parts were scattered about. The display phones were cut from their tethers and removed from the store. A cash register drawer was removed from the front cash register. The drawers adjacent to the main counter were closed. Inside the drawers I located additional cash register drawers containing money. The cooler behind the counter was not operational and being used for storage. Inside the doors I located more money and rolls of coins. The safe located behind the counter was unlocked and contained cash bills in multiple denominations. In the storage cabinets behind the counter I located multiple large containers filled with coins. Nothing else in the business appeared to be disturbed.

The photographs were saved to disk and placed in BEAST.

I completed all necessary paperwork and returned to duty.
