**Re: Freedom of Information Act Request**

Dear Mr Argueta:

On February 6, 2017, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"17-329"

Your request has been granted in part and denied in part. Enclosed are records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records being provided has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA, and that information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, VIN, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including names attributable to home address, employee identification numbers, and home addresses have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy ..." is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, minors' information, an individual's race, a victim's name and identifying information, the names of suspects who were never arrested, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, have been redacted from the records being provided.



On 02/05/17 at 0145 hours, Officer Marchi and I were dispatched to 2449 72nd Court Apt. #2R for a residential burglary which was just discovered. Upon arrival, Officer Marchi and I spoke with the tenant now identified as ██████████ (m/██████████)

██████████ stated on 02/04/17 at 1430 hours, he placed \$650.00 of USC into a pair of black jeans. ██████████ stated he placed the jeans into his closet on the top shelf and left for work. ██████████ was unsure if he locked his apartment door as he walked out for work. At 0030 hours, ██████████ arrived home from work and noticed his apartment door was slightly open. ██████████ entered into his apartment and did not notice anything was out of place. ██████████ then went to his closet and looked into his black jean pocket for his money which was not there. ██████████ looked everywhere in the apartment for the money but was unable to locate it. ██████████ then noticed a gold watch was missing from his dresser, a Wireless Display Receiver "Screen Beam Mini 2" stolen from closet in the bedroom, and two pair of Nike Jordan shoes were taken from the closet next to the front door to apartment. After searching for approximately one hour for his belongings, ██████████ called the police at 0145 hours.

There were no signs of forced entry and all windows were secure to the apartment. ██████████ stated he and his girlfriend are the only two people who have a key to the apartment. ██████████ girlfriend is currently out of town in Florida. ██████████ stated he has no issues with the tenants in the building and could not imagine who would have taken his belongings.

The only entrance to the building is located on the south east corner of the building. The entrance to the building is always locked if the door is closed. ██████████ stated the entrance door was locked when he came home from work. I noticed a camera located on the Caputo's business which faces the entrance door to the building.

██████████ was given a report number and asked to contact the police if he can confirm anything else was stolen from the apartment.
