Re: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Ms. Cintron:

On February 16, 2017, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"17-218"

Your request has been granted in part and denied in part. Enclosed are records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records being provided has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA, and that information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, VIN, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including names employee identification numbers, home or personal telephone numbers, and home addresses, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy ..." is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, minors' information, an individual's race, a victim's name and identifying information, the names of suspects who were never arrested, a third party's information, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, have been redacted from the records being provided.

On 01/22/17, at approximately 1358 hours, I was dispatched to a Burglary call at 1625 N. 76th Court.

Upon arrival, I spoke with [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] who said their garage was burglarized. [REDACTED] said he was notified, by his neighbor, his overhead garage door was open. [REDACTED] said when he walked outside he observed the side door to the garage "busted" open. Upon entering the garage he noticed multiple items missing from inside the garage. [REDACTED] said the items taken consisted of a Craftsman 20-Gallon Air Compressor (Approximately \$700.00), an Electric Wheelchair (Approximately \$2,000.00) and multiple tools from a tool chest (Approximately \$7,000.00-\$8,000.00.) [REDACTED] advised me of the damage to the west door and where all his items were removed from. [REDACTED] did not have any serial numbers for items stolen.

I advised Sergeant Brown via radio we would need an Evidence Technician dispatched to the scene.

ET Giovenco arrived on scene and processed the garage at 1625 N. 76th Court. (See ET Giovenco's report)

I spoke with [REDACTED] who believed the ex-tenant at 1623 N. 76th Ct, now known as [REDACTED] might be involved since he was evicted a few months prior to incident.

As I was speaking with [REDACTED] his neighbor, [REDACTED] (M/[REDACTED]) advised me someone burglarized his garage also. (See RD 17-00219)

On 01/22/17 at 1415 hours I was dispatched to 1625 76th Ct and was the Evidence Technician assigned to process the scene of a burglary to garage. Upon arrival I spoke with Officer Messina who informed of damage to the service door on the west side of the garage.

I photographed the scene as it was. I photographed the damage to the service door which included marks to the door, door frame and deadbolt. I photographed the interior of the garage as it was.

I put on a new pair of rubber gloves and began by checking the tool chest in which the victim stated hand tools were taken from. I then dusted the tool chest for fingerprints and was able to locate a latent fingerprint on the third drawer of the chest. using a hingelifter I was able to lift and collect the fingerprint which was then stored in my squad, unit 345.

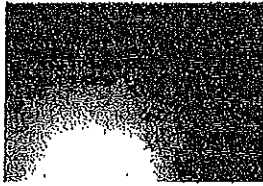
I then dusted a black metal toolbox for fingerprints which the victim stated was moved in the garage which turned up negative results. I then dusted the service door handle for fingerprints which turned up negative results as well.

At the Public Safety Building I printed a contact sheet of the photographs taken and copied the Photographs to two CR-R discs. One disc was placed into BEAST as evidence. I then placed one hingelifter containing the collected fingerprint into BEAST as evidence and submitted the print for AFIS identification.

There is nothing further to report at this time. I returned to active patrol.
