**Re: Freedom of Information Act Request**

Dear Ms. Babinska:

On January 25, 2017, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for "17-205[.]"

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including a driver's license number, home or personal telephone numbers, and home addresses, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy,

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General's Office. 

On 10/21/17 at 1613 hours I was dispatched to 7903 Sunset for a report of a dog bite. Upon arrival I spoke with [REDACTED] F [REDACTED] who stated she was walking her dog on 80th Ave in the area of 7951 Oakleaf when the dog at 7951 Oakleaf bit [REDACTED] dog, Lilly, on the left front paw at 1330 hours.

[REDACTED] stated her dog had already been taken to the animal hospital and was undergoing surgery. She was able to supply me with a photograph of her dog's injuries. See attached photographs.

I went to [REDACTED] and made contact with the resident [REDACTED] M [REDACTED] who stated he was aware there was an incident and was willing to cooperate in any way. [REDACTED] stated his dog, Abby, was a mix breed rescue which last received rabies shot in June of 2016. [REDACTED] was supplied a dog bite card and informed [REDACTED] would be in contact in regards to the expenses.

There is nothing further to report at this time. I returned to active patrol.
