**Re: Freedom of Information Act Request**

Dear Ms. Perez,

On July 11, 2017, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for "17-1534[.]"

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including home or personal telephone numbers and home addresses, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including the races of individuals, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(d)(iv) of FOIA provides that, "[r]ecords in the possession of any public body created in the course of administrative enforcement proceedings, and any law enforcement or correctional agency

for law enforcement purposes” are exempt from disclosure, “but only to the extent that disclosure would: ... unavoidably disclose the identity of a confidential source, confidential information furnished only by the confidential source, or persons who file complaints with or provide information to administrative, investigative, law enforcement, or penal agencies.” Consequently, information that would reveal the identity of persons who filed complaints with or provided information to the Village of Elmwood Park Police Department has been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General’s Office. You can file your Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor by writing to:

If you choose to file a Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor, you must do so within 60 calendar days of the date of this letter. Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this letter when filing a Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor.

You are also notified that you have the right to judicial review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer pursuant to Section 11 of FOIA.

THE INFORMATION BELOW IS CONFIDENTIAL - FOR USE BY AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY

ON 06-23-17 AT 1926 HOURS I RESPONDED TO 2915 74TH AVE #1 FOR A THREAT REPORT, LATER CHANGED TO A DOMESTIC DISTURBANCE. UPON ARRIVAL I MADE CONTACT WITH [REDACTED] AND HER MOTHER [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] STATED SHE HAS TWO CHILDREN WITH [REDACTED] SHE AND [REDACTED] RESIDE AT [REDACTED]. ON 06-23-17 AT APPROXIMATELY 0600 HOURS, SHE AND [REDACTED] GOT INTO A FIGHT. DURING THE COURSE OF THE FIGHT [REDACTED] STRUCK HER IN THE FACE. SHE DID NOT REPORT THE INCIDENT TO THE CHICAGO POLICE DEPARTMENT. [REDACTED] PICKED UP [REDACTED] AND HER CHILDREN AND BROUGHT THEM TO HER RESIDENCE IN ELMWOOD PARK.

DURING THE COURSE OF THE DAY, [REDACTED] STATED SHE RECEIVED A SNAP CHAT FROM [REDACTED] DEPICTING HIM USING COCAINE. AT APPROXIMATELY 1925 HOURS, [REDACTED] CALLED [REDACTED]. DURING THE COURSE OF THE CONVERSATION, [REDACTED] CALLED [REDACTED] A "BITCH" AND INFORMED HER HE WAS GOING TO BLOW HER CAR UP. [REDACTED] AND [REDACTED] BECAME CONCERNED BECAUSE [REDACTED] INFORMED THEM HE WAS ON THE WAY OVER, AND THEY BELIEVED HE WAS UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF DRUGS.

[REDACTED] CALLED [REDACTED] AND I SPOKE WITH HIM ON THE PHONE. WHEN I ASKED [REDACTED] ABOUT BATTERING [REDACTED] EARLIER IN THE DAY, HE TOLD ME TO "PROVE IT." [REDACTED] THEN STATED HE WAS NOT PLANNING ON CREATING A DISTURBANCE, BUT ONLY WANTED TO SEE HIS CHILDREN. [REDACTED] STATED [REDACTED] LAUNDERS MONEY AND THAT THERE ARE DRUGS INSIDE OF HER HOUSE. HE STATED HE DID NOT WANT HIS CHILDREN IN THAT ENVIRONMENT. I RECOMMENDED [REDACTED] REMAIN AT HOME AND RECOMMENDED HE CONTACT AN ATTORNEY REGARDING CUSTODY OF THE CHILDREN.

AT 2032 HOURS I SPOKE ON THE PHONE WITH [REDACTED] SHE ADVISED ME THAT SHORTLY AFTER I DEPARTED, [REDACTED] DROVE UP TO HER AND [REDACTED] AS THEY ENTERED [REDACTED] VEHICLE. [REDACTED] CALLED [REDACTED] A "FUCKING BITCH" AND THEN STATED HE WAS GOING TO KILL HER. [REDACTED] THEN LEFT THE AREA. [REDACTED] DID NOT SEE HIM OR HEAR FROM HIM AGAIN.
