**Re: Freedom of Information Act Request**

Dear Ms. Hanley:

On June 16, 2017, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"Multiple Police Reports from 5/16-4/17  
Laura Hanley  
Joshua Philp @1934 N. 76<sup>th</sup> Ave  
Elmwood Park, IL

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including home or personal telephone numbers and home addresses, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, “[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy” is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including the name of a person who was never arrested, and the races of individuals, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(d)(iv) of FOIA provides that, “[r]ecords in the possession of any public body created in the course of administrative enforcement proceedings, and any law enforcement or correctional agency for law enforcement purposes” are exempt from disclosure, “but only to the extent that disclosure would: ... unavoidably disclose the identity of a confidential source, confidential information furnished only by the confidential source, or persons who file complaints with or provide information to administrative, investigative, law enforcement, or penal agencies.” Consequently, information that would reveal the identity of persons who filed complaints with or provided information to the Village of Elmwood Park Police Department has been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General’s Office. You can file your Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor by writing to:



On 06/12/16, at approximately 1305 hours, I responded to the Elmwood Park Police Department for a domestic disturbance report.

Upon arrival, Sergeant Rosa and I spoke to [REDACTED] in the report room. [REDACTED] told us in summary: [REDACTED] has been married to [REDACTED] for one year (together 10 years). [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] have two children together (7 weeks old/2 years old). [REDACTED] is controlling and shows signs of aggression towards [REDACTED] and her 4 other children . Yesterday, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] argued and he pushed her but she does not want him arrested for it. [REDACTED] took her car keys, house keys and phone and locked them away. [REDACTED] broke items around the house. [REDACTED] wanted to cool off and [REDACTED] blocked [REDACTED] from leaving the house. [REDACTED] feels like she is walking on egg shells around [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] have separate bank accounts and she has \$1200USC in her account. In the past, [REDACTED] has taken money out of [REDACTED] account without her permission. [REDACTED] does not have any close family locally but has an ex-husband in River Forest that may be willing to help her.

I did not observe any signs of physical injury to [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] wanted advice on her options. Sergeant Rosa and I explained how to obtain an order of protection. At 1325 hours, I contacted Sarah's Inn (708-386-4225) and spoke to employee, Jennifer. I briefed Jennifer of the incident. [REDACTED] discussed further options with Jennifer.

I gave [REDACTED] the contact information to Sarah's Inn and Maybrook Courthouse. I gave [REDACTED] the report number.

Sergeant Rosa gave [REDACTED] the domestic violence information handout.

Upon my arrival I spoke with caller [REDACTED] who was outside by her vehicle and she told me her husband was in their residence. [REDACTED] related that she was just at a marriage counselor with her husband [REDACTED]. On there way home they were in a verbal dispute. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] would not let her out of [REDACTED] vehicle until his vehicle was returned to him. Sgt. Rosa and Ofc Barrile arrived on scene. Sgt Rosa and Ofc Barrile stayed with [REDACTED] outside and Ofc Frasco and I walked into residence and spoke with [REDACTED] who was putting groceries away. I asked [REDACTED] what happened and he stated he never held her in the car he just wanted to put the groceries away and [REDACTED] kept locking and unlocking the vehicle's doors. [REDACTED] stated that he needs his vehicle's keys so he could get to work. [REDACTED] daughter dropped [REDACTED] car off [REDACTED] stated that he was gonna shower and go to work. On 03/25/2017, at 1727 hours, Sgt Rosa, Officer Alequin and I were dispatched to 1934 N 76th Av for Domestic Trouble.

Upon our arrival, I spoke to caller now known to be [REDACTED] (m [REDACTED]) and Sgt Rosa went to the second floor to speak to [REDACTED] (f [REDACTED]).

[REDACTED] told me, he was arguing with his wife [REDACTED] over text messages he had received from a co-worker that were work related. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] he didn't want to argue anymore and was going to go into his office in the basement. [REDACTED] began to walk down the basement stairs and [REDACTED] pushed him.

[REDACTED] told me, he was fine and wanted [REDACTED] to leave for the evening.

I explained to [REDACTED] that I would like to speak to [REDACTED].

I spoke to [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] told me, she was arguing with [REDACTED] and told him that she was going to talk to a divorce attorney on Monday. [REDACTED] got mad and took [REDACTED] keys so she couldn't leave. [REDACTED] went to go into his office in the basement and she slammed the basement door.

[REDACTED] stated she never touched [REDACTED].

[REDACTED] thinks [REDACTED] is trying to make her look bad by calling the Police on her if they end up getting divorced.

I explained to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] that I cannot make either party leave the house.

[REDACTED] was concerned that [REDACTED] would not let her return to the house once she left.

I explained to both parties that [REDACTED] was able to return at a later time.

[REDACTED] decided to leave for a while and would return at a later time.

Prior to completing the report Sgt Rosa, Officer Alequin and I were called back to the residence for an escort.

[REDACTED] returned to the house. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] began to argue over a cell phone.

Officers stood by while [REDACTED] gathered some belongings for the evening and was given her old cell phone.

Nothing further at this time and I returned to patrol.
