The Village of Elmwood Park is in receipt of your June 19, 2017, Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

Narrative Summary of Events

Dispatched for the pt with AMS and low oxygen saturation. U/a EMS crew noted the pt was supine on a hospital type bed, a/o x 0/0, GCS 6, and with an respiratory RN administering 2.5mg of Albuterol via a mask. RN staff advised the pt was last seen of norm approx 5-10 minutes prior to EMS arrival. Staff advised the pt was normally non-verbal and capable of following commands. EMS crew noted the pt's lung sounds were audible in all fields. EMS crew noted the pt had shallow respirations with a rate of 16-20 per minute and had no accessory muscle usage. EMS crew administered 15LPM of oxygen to the pt due to the pt's shallow respirations. EMS crew noted respiratory arrest was not imminent while with EMS crew. Due to the pt's lung sounds the EMS crew contacted Gottlieb with orders on a fluid bolus of normal saline. Gottlieb gave orders for the 200ml fluid bolus of Normal Saline. Gottlieb advised intubation should be considered. EMS crew communicated to Gottlieb that the pt's airway was not compromised while with the EMS crew and was at 100% oxygen saturation. Transported pt to Gottlieb ER w/o incident. Transferred pt care to Gottlieb ER RN Room 2. All times are approximate.

*Due to pt's blood pressure the EMS crew prepared the intubation equipment and noted intubation was not necessary due to the pt's patent airway.
