Re: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Ms. Rangel:

On March 15, 2017, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"17-648"

Your request has been granted in part and denied in part. Enclosed are records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records being provided has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA, and that information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including employee identification numbers, home or personal telephone numbers, and home addresses have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy ..." is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, an individual's race, a minor's name and identifying information, a victim's name and identifying information, the names of suspects who were never arrested, third party's identifying information, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would

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constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, have been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General's Office. You can file your Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor by writing to:



THE INFORMATION BELOW IS CONFIDENTIAL FOR USE BY AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY

ON 03/14/2017 AT 0800 HOURS I RESPONDED TO THE INTERSECTION OF 74TH AVE/GEORGE FOR A DOG BITE CALL.

UPON MY ARRIVAL I WAS MET BY THE VICTIM YOLANDA RANGEL, RANGEL TOLD ME SHE EXITED HER HOME AT [REDACTED] TO MOVE HER VEHICLE OFF OF 74TH AVENUE FOR SNOW REMOVAL. AS SHE WAS ATTEMPTING TO ENTER HER HOME A DOG CAME RUNNING FROM THE WEST SIDE OF THE 2900 BLOCK OF 74TH AVE TOWARD HER. THE ANIMAL BARKED AT HER AND FORCED HER TO JUMP OFF HER PORCH INTO THE BUSHES. THE DOG BIT HER RIGHT FOOT / BOOT AND RAN OFF AS THE OWNER CAME FROM ACROSS THE STREET TO GET THE ANIMAL. RANGEL SHOWED ME HER BOOT WHICH HAD BEEN RIPPED FROM THE DOG BITE. I ALSO CHECKED FOR INJURIES TO RANGEL AND WAS UNABLE TO SEE ANY SIGNS OF VISIBLE INJURY TO HER.

AFTER SPEAKING TO RANGEL I SPOKE TO A FEMALE WHO IDENTIFIED HERSELF AS [REDACTED] THE OWNER OF THE DOG. [REDACTED] TOLD ME THE DOG NAMED "ROCKY" WAS A 1.5 YR OLD PITBULL / LAB MIX. SHE HAD GOTTEN THE DOG LESS THEN 1 WEEK AGO AND DID NOT HAVE ANY INFORMATION ON HIS SHOTS. [REDACTED] TOLD ME HER MOTHER HAD BEEN SHOVELING SNOW AND THE GATE TO THE YARD AT 2910 74TH AVE WHERE SHE LIVES HAD BEEN LEFT OPEN. "ROCKY" EXITED THE YARD THROUGH THE OPEN GATE AND RAN AT RANGEL BITING HER ON HER RIGHT FOOT. I COMPLETED A COOK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ANIMAL AND RABIES CONTROL CARD.

[REDACTED] WAS GIVEN PAGE 2 OF THE COOK COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF ANIMAL AND RABIES CONTROL CARD AND TOLD TO FOLLOW THE INSTRUCTIONS.

UPON COMPLETION OF THIS REPORT I CONTINUED MY REGULAR PATROL DUTIES.
