Dear Mr. LaFronza:

On December 27, 2016, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"I am requesting a copy of the original police report from my arrest regarding case #15 CR 1034201, date of arrest 9-6-15, IR # 0571220, SID # 021479720.

Any and all reports regarding this case please."

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain

unique identifiers, including driver's license numbers, personal financial information, home or personal telephone numbers, home addresses, personal license plates, and signatures, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, the name of a suspect who was never arrested, and the races of individuals, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(d)(iv) of FOIA provides that, "[r]ecords in the possession of any public body created in the course of administrative enforcement proceedings, and any law enforcement or correctional agency for law enforcement purposes" are exempt from disclosure, "but only to the extent that disclosure would: ... unavoidably disclose the identity of a confidential source, confidential information furnished only by the confidential source, or persons who file complaints with or provide information to administrative, investigative, law enforcement, or penal agencies." Consequently, information that would reveal the identity of persons who filed complaints with or provided information to the Village of Elmwood Park Police Department has been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General's Office. On 05/17/15, at 1315 hours I handled a Burglary report at 2400 N Harlem Ave (Caputo's). I met with the victim [redacted] (F [redacted]) at her car. Her car was located in the main parking located at Grand and 73rd Ave. [redacted] stated an unknown person took her purse off the passenger seat of her car (IL Reg [redacted]) as she returned her shopping cart to Caputo's. [redacted] stated she left the vehicle unlocked. I did not observe any signs of forced entry to the vehicle. It did not appear that the vehicle had been ransacked. I did not locate anything of evidentiary value inside the vehicle. I photographed the vehicle. I viewed video footage of the incident. I observed an approximately 5'10, 220 lbs, white male, wearing a gray shirt with blue 3/4 length sleeves, shorts, and white gym shoes follow [redacted] to her vehicle. I observed [redacted] leave her vehicle to return her cart. I observed the male enter the vehicle on the driver's side, retrieve the purse, and then flee northbound through the lot. It appeared that the offender fled through the west alley of the 2400 block of 72nd Ct.


The following is a summary of my investigation as it pertains to RD #15-4651:

I spoke to [REDACTED] over the phone, [REDACTED] said one of her credit cards was used after she noticed it was missing and another credit card was "denied" possibly at the same location. [REDACTED] said the cards were used at "Taco Burrito King" in "Chicago".

There is a Taco Burrito King in the area of Harlem Ave and Belmont Ave in Chicago at 3216 N. Harlem Ave., approximately eight (8) blocks from the Caputo's lot where [REDACTED] vehicle was burglarized.

I spoke to Taco Burrito King employee [REDACTED], (5413 W. Belmont Ave, Chicago, IL 773-777-6200). [REDACTED] explained the 5413 Belmont Ave location runs the video for numerous Taco Burrito King locations. [REDACTED] said she would preserve the video and requested a credit or debit card number to narrow down the transaction at the store.

I picked up the video surveillance recordings from Caputo's loss prevention.

I viewed the surveillance recordings. In the recording I could see a male subject standing in the parking lot. The subject followed [REDACTED] to her car and watched her put her groceries in her car trunk. When [REDACTED] walked from her car to put her cart away, the male subject walked to the driver's side front door of her car, opened it and removed items from the car. The male subject walks north through the parking lot out of view of the camera

The subject in the Caputo's lot video matches the subject Ofc. LaPenna and Ofc. Alequin talked to on 05-18-15, (see Ofc. LaPenna's Investigative Action for Mario LaFronza m [REDACTED] 7155 W. Diversey Ave room 4). The subject in the video recording appears to be wearing the same shirt worn by Mario when he was photographed by Ofc. LaPenna and Ofc. Alequin.

The subject in the video is also wearing light colored shorts and light colored shoes, as is Mario in the photo taken on 05-18-15.

[REDACTED] came to the Elmwood Park Police station with a printout of the transaction history for her [REDACTED] debit card # [REDACTED]. I viewed a transaction for \$37.32 which posted on 05-18-15. [REDACTED] said she did not make any purchases at Taco Burrito King and I could see her bank credited her for the amount of \$37.32. I suggested [REDACTED] contact the Chicago Police to make a report of her card being used in Chicago.

Det. Astrella and I went to Taco Burrito King at 5413 W. Belmont Ave. [REDACTED] gave me a compact disc with video recordings from 05-17-15 at Taco Burrito King 3216 N. Harlem Ave, Chicago.

I reviewed the video from 05-17-15 at Taco Burrito King 3216 N. Harlem Ave. I viewed a male subject in a blue shirt, light colored shorts and light colored shoes making a purchase at approximately 1350 hours. The subject appears to be the same subject seen in the video on 05-17-15 at Caputo's going into [REDACTED] vehicle. The subject also appears to be the same subject Ofc. LaPenna and Ofc. Alequin spoke to on 05-18-15, named Mario LaFronza.

When watching the video recording I could see the subject hand the Taco Burrito King clerk two credit/debit cards which both appear to have been denied. The third card the subject gives to the clerk appears to have been approved and the subject signs a receipt for the purchase.

Ofc. LaPenna and Ofc. Alequin located Mario LaFronza at 7155 W. Diversey Ave, Chicago. He was taken into custody and transported to the Elmwood Park Police station, (see Ofc. LaPenna's investigative action).

I showed Mario a picture of him from 05-18-15. Mario looked at the picture. He identified himself and said the clothing he is wearing in the picture are his clothes. He identified the shoes as his "polo shoes". Mario said the picture was from the day he talked to the police on Harlem Ave by the Walgreens. In the picture behind Mario you can see Walgreens. Mario signed the photo of himself and wrote "that's me" on the picture. I asked Mario if he goes to Caputo's and Taco Burrito King. Mario said he goes to Caputo's about 2 times a week to shop and he goes to Taco Burrito King to eat. I asked Mario if he took a purse out of a car at Caputo's and Mario told us he has not committed a crime since about 2003. I reminded Mario he was arrested in 2012 and he laughed saying, "oh ya". Mario said he lives at Harlem and Diversey Ave and goes to Taco Burrito King to eat. Mario said he takes medicines such as lithium and depression medicine and sometimes he acts crazy and does bad things. Mario said he got out of jail on April 10th. Mario looked at the picture of himself at Taco Burrito King, wearing the same clothes and said that looks like me, but it definitely isn't me. Mario told me he does not have any credit or debit cards.

Det. Astrella and I ended the interview. We walked Mario downstairs to the lockup area and placed him in cell a-2.

I contacted felony review and charges were approved by ASA Reardon on 06-09-15, 1310 hours for burglary to auto and identify theft.

Mario was fingerprinted and processed according to Elmwood Park Police procedures. Mario was prepared for bond court in the morning. Copies of the complaints were placed with Mario's property.

I placed the surveillance DVD's from Caputo's and Taco Burrito King into evidence. I placed Mario's personal property into evidence to be picked up at a later date. I placed \$631.00 US currency which was in Mario's possession into BEAST evidence system.

██████████ came to the station and signed the two complaints. I advised ██████████ of the initial court date and time.


