Dear Mr. Kirykowicz:

On May 15, 2017, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for "17-1114[.]"

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including home or personal telephone numbers and home addresses, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy,

On 05/09/2017, at 1602 hours, Officer Giovenco and I responded to report a burglary, which was just discovered, at 1846 77th Av.

Upon arrival, We spoke with the resident (George A Kirykowicz DOB [REDACTED]) who said the house had been burglarized. George stated his son ([REDACTED] DOB [REDACTED]) lives there and George comes by everyday around 1300 hours to check the mail.

George said he arrived at the home at approximately 1500 hours today and noticed the kitchen window and sliding doors were open. George said he started looking around the house and noticed the lights were on in various rooms. George said he noticed the doors to the bedrooms were open, which he said are always closed, and started looking around. George said his Rolex watch, his wife's Rolex watch, and his wife's engagement ring were missing. George said he went downstairs to the basement where he noticed at least six guitars (unknown make/unknown model) missing. George said he is unsure of what else is missing at this time.

George described his Rolex watch as the Presidential edition with a white face with diamonds and all gold band. George described his wife's Rolex watch as a female version of the Presidential edition with a black face with diamonds and a gold/silver band. George described his wife's engagement ring as white gold or platinum with one large diamond in the center and three small stones on the left and right side of the large diamond.

We asked George about [REDACTED] schedule and he said [REDACTED] is gone from home everyday from about 0600 hours to about 1800 hours. We asked George if [REDACTED] was home last night and he was unsure.

Officer Giovenco was the Evidence Technician assigned to process the scene (See report).

George was given the report number and left a supplement property list form to complete. We advised George to speak with [REDACTED] to complete the form and return it to the Elmwood Park Police Department as soon as possible.

Officer Giovenco contacted [REDACTED] via telephone (Tx [REDACTED]) told Officer Giovenco he was unsure if he locked everything up. [REDACTED] told him he was home alone from approximately 1700 hours 05/08/2017 to approximately 0615 hours 05/09/2017. [REDACTED] told him he does not have any discrepancies with anyone. Officer Giovenco advised [REDACTED] to fill out the supplemental property list form we left with George and return it to the Elmwood Park Police Department as soon as possible.

On 05/09/17 at 1614 hours I arrived on scene at 1846 77th Ave and was assigned as the Evidence Technician to process the scene of a burglary which was just discovered. Upon arrival I put on a new pair of rubber gloves, entered the residence and spoke with the resident George A Kirykowicz, M [REDACTED] who stated he arrived home at the residence at approximately 1330 hours he discovered the kitchen window on the south wall open and the sliding door of the west wall of the kitchen open.

I photographed the exterior of the residence as it was. I then entered the residence and photographed the interior of the residence as it was. I first checked the kitchen window which was discovered open for possible fingerprints. Both the interior and exterior of the window were dirt covered and had no signs of fingerprints of smudge marks.

I then dusted the sliding door for possible fingerprints which turned up negative results.

I then entered the bedroom on the first floor, south side of the residence. I observed multiple dresser drawers open as well as an open jewelry box, and two open empty Rolex watch boxes. I dusted the dresser for possible fingerprints which turned up negative results.

I then entered the first floor bedroom on the north side of the residence. I observed the dresser on the east wall to have multiple open drawers as well as the night stand on the north wall with two open drawers. I dusted both the dresser and night stand for possible fingerprints which turned up negative results.

At the Public Safety Building I printed a contact sheet of the photographs taken and printed them to two CD-R discs. One disc was placed into BEAST as evidence.

There is nothing further to report at this time. I returned to active patrol.
