**Re: Freedom of Information Act Request**

Dear Ms. Marianek:

On May 5, 2017, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"COPY OF POLICE REPORT # 17-920. COMPLAINANT [*sic*] WAS MY BROTHER. HE IS NOW DECEASED AND I AM TAKING OVER HIS AFFAIRS. I HAVE POWER OF ATTORNEY."

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including a home or personal telephone number and a home addresses, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, “[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy” is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, a birthdate, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including the race of an individual, have been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General’s Office. You can file your Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor by writing to:



THE INFORMATION BELOW IS CONFIDENTIAL - FOR USE BY AUTHORIZED PERSONNEL ONLY

ON 04/18/17, AT APPROXIMATELY 1202 HOURS, I RESPONDED TO 7940 WESTWOOD DR REGARDING A RADIO DISPATCHED CALL IN REFERENCE TO A THEFT (>\$500).

UPON ARRIVING, I SPOKE TO CALLER RALPH J CIANGI (M [REDACTED] (TX [REDACTED]) WHO STATED SOMETIME BETWEEN WEDNESDAY, 04/12/17, AND MONDAY, 04/17/17, ONE OF THE FEW CAREGIVERS ASSIGNED TO TAKE CARE OF HIM, STOLE \$1,580 IN USC FROM HIM. IN ADDITION, RALPH STATED SOMETIME ON SATURDAY, 04/15/17, ONE OF THE FEW CAREGIVERS STOLE HIS CELLPHONE. RALPH STATED HE REPORTED THE INCIDENTS TO INTERIM HEALTHCARE (TX 630.359.6660), THE COMPANY THAT PROVIDES THE CAREGIVERS TO HIM, ON MONDAY, 04/17/17. RALPH STATED HE NOTIFIED "VINCE," THE MANAGER, AND "BERNIE," THE OWNER OF INTERIM HEALTHCARE LOCATED IN ELMHURST, IL. RALPH STATED BOTH VINCE AND BERNIE TOLD HIM THEY WOULD CONDUCT THEIR OWN INVESTIGATION OF THE INCIDENTS BUT COULD NOT START UNTIL HE PROVIDED THEM WITH A POLICE REPORT NUMBER. RALPH STATED HE INFORMED THE ELMWOOD PARK POLICE DEPARTMENT OF THE INCIDENT SO THAT HE COULD PROVIDE THE REPORT NUMBER TO INTERIM HEALTHCARE FOR THEIR INVESTIGATION.

RALPH STATED HE PLACED HIS CELLPHONE ON HIS DESK (LIVING ROOM) EARLY MORNING ON SATURDAY, 04/15/17. RALPH STATED HE RETURNED TO HIS DESK FOR HIS CELLPHONE LATER SATURDAY AND THE CELLPHONE WAS NO LONGER THERE. RALPH STATED HE THOUGHT HE MISPLACED IT SO HE CONDUCTED A THOROUGH SEARCH OF HIS HOME, WHICH WAS MET WITH NEGATIVE RESULTS. RALPH STATED HE INFORMED HIS CELL CARRIER, CONSUMER CELLULAR, OF THE INCIDENT ON MONDAY, 04/17/17. RALPH STATED CONSUMER CELLULAR DISCONTINUED THE SERVICE ON HIS CELLPHONE AND REPLACED IT WITH A NEW CELLPHONE FOR A FEE OF \$50 USC. RALPH STATED THE VALUE OF THE OLD PHONE WAS \$50 USC BUT WAS UNABLE TO PROVIDE ANY FURTHER INFORMATION ON THE CELLPHONE (I.E. MAKE, MODEL, SERIAL NUMBER, ETC).

RALPH STATED HIS CAREGIVER TOOK HIM TO RUN A FEW ERRANDS ON WEDNESDAY, 04/12/17, AND WHEN THEY RETURNED, HE HAD \$80 USC IN HIS WALLET (REAR POCKET) AND \$1,500 USC LOOSE IN THE FRONT POCKET OF HIS PANTS. RALPH STATED HE TOOK HIS PANTS OFF, LAID THEM OUT ON HIS BED (BEDROOM) AND PUT ON LOUNGING PANTS. RALPH STATED HE SPENT THE MAJORITY OF HIS TIME IN LOUNGING PANTS IN THE BACK ROOM OF HIS HOUSE WHERE HE WATCHES TV, NAPS AND SLEEPS. RALPH STATED HE RETURNED TO HIS BEDROOM ON MONDAY 04/17/17 AT APPROXIMATELY 1500 HOURS, GRABBED THE PANTS THAT HE HAD LAID ON THE BED ON WEDNESDAY, 04/12/17, PUT THEM ON AND WENT SHOPPING WITH A DIFFERENT CAREGIVER. RALPH STATED, WHEN THEY ARRIVED AT THE STORE, HE REACHED INTO HIS FRONT POCKET AND NOTICED THE \$1,500 USC WAS MISSING. RALPH STATED HE THEN REMOVED HIS WALLET FROM HIS REAR POCKET AND NOTICED THE \$80 USC WAS MISSING FROM HIS WALLET. RALPH STATED HE RETURNED HOME AND IMMEDIATELY NOTIFIED INTERIM HEALTHCARE OF THE MISSING MONEY AND CELLPHONE.
