Re: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Mr. Prasovic:

On May 1, 2017, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for "17-00919[.]"

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including home or personal telephone numbers, home addresses, and a signature, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, including a victim's name and identifying information, the name of a third party who incidentally appears in a police report, and the races of individuals, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(d)(iv) of FOIA provides that, "[r]ecords in the possession of any public body created in the course of administrative enforcement proceedings, and any law enforcement or correctional agency

for law enforcement purposes” are exempt from disclosure, “but only to the extent that disclosure would: ... unavoidably disclose the identity of a confidential source, confidential information furnished only by the confidential source, or persons who file complaints with or provide information to administrative, investigative, law enforcement, or penal agencies.” Consequently, information that would reveal the identity of persons who filed complaints with or provided information to the Village of Elmwood Park Police Department has been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General’s Office. You can file your Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor by writing to:

If you choose to file a Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor, you must do so within 60 calendar days of the date of this letter. Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this letter when filing a Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor.

You are also notified that you have the right to judicial review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer pursuant to Section 11 of FOIA.

On 04-18-2017 at 1054 hours, Ofc Messina and I responded to 1641 73rd Ct on a Burglary. Upon my arrival I spoke with [REDACTED] related that he lives with 3 room mates. [REDACTED] sleeps in the basement. On this date, [REDACTED] woke up went up stairs and observed the TV and Play station was missing from the front room. I also spoke with [REDACTED] stated that he left for school at 0825 hours and the TV and other items where in the front room. I checked area and found there was no force entry to residence. [REDACTED] related that maybe he didn't lock the door when he left for school. I spoke with residents at 1638,1640,1647 73rd Ct and no-one saw or heard anything. The resident at 1645 73rd Ct has surveillance cameras but no one answered the door. Lost items [REDACTED] - Play station controller. [REDACTED] - Vizio TV. [REDACTED] - Play station 4 and \$300.00 usc in Play station games.

The following are my actions as an evidence technician in the reported Burglary on 04/18/17 at 1641 N. 73rd Court.

After the scene was secure, I photographed the scene as it was.

The victim believed the offender may have touched the front doorknob, a Playstation 4 remote and possibly left out the side door. I dusted the front doorknob, remote and side doorknob. I observed a latent fingerprint on the front doorknob and remote. I photographed both fingerprints with dust applied. I used a hinge lifter to collect the visible prints but was unable to secure a usable print.

The victims advised me they did not wish to produce elimination prints.

I copied all photographs to a DVD and inventoried the copies per department policy.

-Nothing Further-

I spoke to [redacted] on 04-20-17 and he said he did not believe anyone's prints would be on the lifts taken by the police other than his or his roommates. This is why he and his roommates did not give their elimination prints. [redacted] said there are several roommates and they have lots of friends and teammates over to hang out and there are lots of people who could have taken their belongings. [redacted] said a neighbor has video cameras which he reviewed and he does not believe there is anything on the cameras which may help with the case. [redacted] said there is a car in the video but the video isnt good enough to see anything.

[redacted] said he does not have serial numbers for any of the missing items.

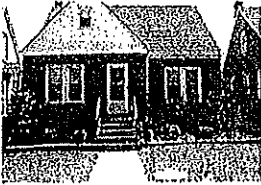
I advised [redacted] to call if he had any further information.
