Re: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Mr. Pohanka:

On May 31, 2018, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"Request report 18-1218"

Your request has been granted in part and denied in part. Enclosed are records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records being provided has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA, and that information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, VIN, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2 (c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, such as driver's license numbers, home or personal telephone numbers, home addresses, and personal license plates have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy ..." is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, minors' information, an individual's race, a victim's name and identifying information, a third party's name and identifying information, the name and identifying information of suspects who were never arrested, and other personal information, the disclosure of which

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would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (d) (iv) of FOIA provides that, “[r]ecords in the possession of any public body created in the course of administrative enforcement proceedings, and any law enforcement or correctional agency for law enforcement purposes...” are exempt from disclosure, “but only to the extent that disclosure would...unavoidably disclose the identity of a confidential source, confidential information furnished only by the confidential source, or persons who file complaints with or provide information to administrative, investigative, law enforcement, or penal agencies...” Consequently, information that would reveal the identity of persons who have filed complaints with or who have provided information to the Village of Elmwood Park Police Department has been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General’s Office. On 05/24/18, at 2248 hours, WESCOM provided 1st watch officers with a flash from the Illinois State Police. Per ISP, a black vehicle struck a state trooper's patrol vehicle and then fled the area. WESCOM advised that the vehicle was driving on rims and was last seen driving westbound on Belmont Ave from Thatcher Ave., by a River Grove unit.

Ofc Borrini informed 1st watch officers via radio, that he located the offending vehicle (IL Reg [REDACTED] in the 3200 block of N Pacific Ave in Chicago. Ofc Borrini provided a description of the offenders which he obtained from multiple witnesses (see Ofc Borrini's investigative action).

Ofc Borrini further related that he observed 2 subjects matching the description of the offenders, sitting at the bus stop located at 79th Ave. and Belmont Ave.

I made contact with the subjects, now known as Keith J Reed (M/ [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] Keith stated he was staying at [REDACTED] residence "down the street." Keith stated he was waiting for his friend to pick him up. Keith stated his friend would be arriving shortly in a black Chevrolet Impala,

Ofc Loni arrived on scene.

CPD 1631R arrived on scene.

While speaking to [REDACTED] and Keith, I observed a black Chevrolet Impala (IL Reg [REDACTED], driving east on Belmont Ave.

Ofc Loni curbed the vehicle in the 3100 block of 79th Ave to determine if the occupants were involved in ISP's hit and run.

CPD 1631R stood by with [REDACTED] and Keith, while I assisted Ofc Loni. Ofc Loni identified the occupants of the vehicle as [REDACTED] and [REDACTED]

While speaking to [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] Ofc Loni informed me that Keith was running from 1631R.

I observed Keith running southbound in the 3100 block of 79th Ave directly toward me.

I wrapped my arms around Keith and pulled him to the ground with the assistance of Ofc Loni. Keith was secured in handcuffs.

Illinois State Police, Deputy J Rokowski (#6229 beat C135) arrived on scene. I turned over Keith to Deputy Rokowski's custody.

The scene was turned over to the Illinois State Police. See ISP Accident report # 03-18-8042 for further.

On 05/24/2018 at approximately 2248 hours I was searching the area of the 7900 Block of Belmont Ave for a black Dodge Charger driving on the rims, which River Grove Police were attempting to locate and was last seen eastbound Belmont Ave from Thatcher Ave. I was advised by Dispatch the vehicle was wanted in connection with a hit and run and struck a Illinois State Police squad.

I was searching the area and located the vehicle in the alley behind FIZZ restaurant located on the 7900 Block of Belmont Ave in Chicago.

I observed a tow truck driver parked in the alley along with two subjects standing near the vehicle.

I identified the subjects as [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] related they observed the Dodge Charger driving eastbound on Belmont Ave at a high rate of speed and turn in the alley behind FIZZ restaurant.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] stated they observed three to four subjects exit the vehicle and run southbound through the empty lot, then eastbound on Belmont Ave.

[REDACTED] described two subjects as one male, Black and tall and the other as a female Black.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were unable to provide any clothing description.

Prior to locating the vehicle, I observed a female and male subject, with the male subject matching the description, sitting at the bus stop located on the corner of 79th Ave and Belmont Ave, in close proximity of the location of the Dodge Charger.

I advised Disptach of my discovery and the location of the subjects matching the description.

Officers LaPenna and Loni made contact with the subjects at the bus stop (see Officer LaPenna's report).

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] refused to relocate for a show up.

Illinois State Police Officers arrived on scene, and I referred the witnesses to them.
