Re: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Ms. Mendoza:

On June 19, 2018, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"...police report number 18-01479 and its accompanying audio of the 911 call."

Your request has been granted in part and denied in part. Enclosed are records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records being provided has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA, and that information has been redacted from the records being provided or withheld from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, VIN, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2 (c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, such as driver's license numbers, home or personal telephone numbers, home addresses, and personal license plates have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy ..." is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, minor's name and identifying information, an individual's

race, a victim's name and identifying information, a third party's name and identifying information, the name and identifying information of suspects who were never arrested, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (d) (iv) of FOIA provides that, "[r]ecords in the possession of any public body created in the course of administrative enforcement proceedings, and any law enforcement or correctional agency for law enforcement purposes..." are exempt from disclosure, "but only to the extent that disclosure would...unavoidably disclose the identity of a confidential source, confidential information furnished only by the confidential source, or persons who file complaints with or provide information to administrative, investigative, law enforcement, or penal agencies..." Consequently, information that would reveal the identity of persons who have filed complaints with or who have provided information to the Village of Elmwood Park Police Department has been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General's Office. You can file your Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor by writing to:

If you choose to file a Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor, you must do so within 60 calendar days of the date of this letter. Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this letter when filing a Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor.

You are also notified that you have the right to judicial review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer pursuant to Section 11 of FOIA.

On 06/18/2018, at 1908 hours, Commander Busch, Officer Zelasco and I were dispatched 1844 N 74th Ct for a Welfare Check.

While enroute WSCDC advised responding officers, suspect known to be [REDACTED] was mentally unstable, recently suicidal, suffering from anxiety and paranoia. He is currently off of his medications .

[REDACTED] was last seen wearing a black shirt, black shorts, black flip flops, ankle monitoring bracelet on his ankle. He was running west bound Cortland St.

Upon my arrival I met caller/sister [REDACTED]. She told me, her boyfriend was looking for her brother. He ran west bound Cortland two side street and then turned right. He was hiding in bushes per her boyfriend. [REDACTED] has been acting strange all day. He ran out of the house yelling.

I updated Commander Busch and Officer Zelasco the last location [REDACTED] was seen.

Officers began checking the area.

Cso Tristiano notified responding Officers, [REDACTED] last location was 7700 block Bloomingdale Av.

I responded to the area.

I located [REDACTED] walking north bound 1800 block of 78th Av. [REDACTED] did not have his black flip flops on at that time. I pulled over, rolled down my right front door window and asked [REDACTED] to come over to my squad car. He complied. I told him that I'd like to talk to him and as I exited my police car [REDACTED] took off running south bound 1800 block 78th Av to east bound Bloomingdale. I ran after [REDACTED] and was able to stop him at Bloomingdale and 77th Ct west Alley. [REDACTED] and I fell to the ground.

Commander Busch and Officer Zelasco arrived on scene.

I ran after [REDACTED] because I thought he was a danger to himself. He started to scream and became aggressive. I placed handcuffs on [REDACTED] for his safety. He stated he did not feel good. He requested water because he was going to throw up. He began to cough very loud and gag.

I requested and ambulance to our location.

[REDACTED] was yelling for us to call his uncle, call the mayor, call the chief, call the president and call his attorney, I'm not talking. He was yelling shoot me, don't shoot me, I'm kidding. He began screaming help, help, I'm fine, let me go, take me to the hospital.

[REDACTED] was rolling around on the ground. He was attempting to stand up. He was told multiple times to stop yelling, and sit down. The ambulance is on the way. He was refusing to listen to responding officers commands.

Officer Zelasco inquired about the ankle monitor on [REDACTED] ankle. He told Officer Zelasco that he had an alcohol problem in the past. He is on a monitor now.

Officer Zelasco asked [REDACTED] where his shoes were. [REDACTED] told Officer Zelasco that he had on his running shoes.

[REDACTED] mentioned he was a teacher at the Elmwood Park Middle School. Then he would talk about the weather, become fidgety, agitated and have screaming out bursts that made no sense.

Sergeant Rosa arrived on scene.

Elmwood Park Fire Department and Paramedics arrived on scene.

[REDACTED] was using vulgar language and yelling we hurt him everytime he was touched by paramedics.

I explained the nature of the call to the paramedics.

They requested that the caller who was [REDACTED] respond to our location.

[REDACTED] arrived on scene.

[REDACTED] told the paramedics, [REDACTED] never stated he was a danger to himself. She does not think he took his medications and wanted the police to bring him back home.

The paramedics called Gottlieb ER and [REDACTED] was transported to the hospital.

I entered the 911 radio CD in Beast inventory system.
