Re: Freedom of Information Act Request

Dear Mr. Kucaj:

On August 19, 2019, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Illinois Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"Copy of police report indicent on 8/16/2019
19-02040"

Enclosed please find the records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records responsive to your FOIA request has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA. Accordingly, such information has been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2(c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers, including a home or personal telephone number, and home addresses, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7(1)(c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal

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privacy" is exempt from disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, an individual's race, name and identifying information suspects not arrested, third party's name and identifying information, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, have been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General's Office. You can file your Request for Review with the Public Access Counselor by writing to:



On 08/16/2019, at approximately 1701 hours, I was dispatched to the address of occurrence for a report of Criminal Damage to Property. Upon my arrival, I spoke with complainant (F

reported being in her unit and hearing 2 to 3 loud banging noises. She exited to investigate and observed the building's main entrance door's glass window broken out and glass on the floor. She looked closer and a male white subject, now identified as (M, passed her near the door. She asked him what happened and he said he was locked out of the building and had to get inside. She said she was going to call the police and he told her to go ahead and call said he then went inside, carrying a case of beer.

said she tried calling the Condo Association, but it was closed because it was after 1700 hours, so she left a message. told me she believed the subject lived in Unit and that he drove a grey sedan that was parked in the rear lot.

I requested an additional unit and a camera to photograph the damage.

Cmdr. Kmiecik and Ofc. Marino arrived on scene.

Cmdr. Kmiecik photographed the damage (attached).

I ran vehicle information to determine his identity. Cmdr Kmiecik observed open alcohol inside the vehicle.

All officers relocated to Unit where we made contact with was intoxicated and admitted to destroying the door's glass window in order to gain entry. He said his keys were inside his apartment so he could not get in, and that he used the metal smoker's post outside to strike the glass with. He said that he works and has money and that he would pay to repair the damages.

We advised him he needed to clean up the glass before someone injured themselves walking around and he agreed he would.
