Things get rolling at 12 p.m. on Saturday, August 13th until 11 p.m. Music begins at 2:30 p.m. The headliner, The Shagadelics, will perform from 9pm to 10:30pm.

The fourth and final day of Taste begins at noon and runs until 10 p.m. Musical acts will begin performing at 1:30 with the headliner for the evening, Libido Funk Circus, performing from 7:45pm to 9:30pm.

"We're very happy to have the bocce tournament again this year," Lollino said. "The competition for the Mayor's Cup should be strong."
