Dear Mr. Leonard:

On February 15, 2019, the Village of Elmwood Park received your Freedom of Information Act (5 ILCS 140/1 *et seq.*) ("FOIA") request for the following records:

"Police reports concerning or pertaining to the burglary at Tzonev Foods dba Trattoria Peppino, 7440 W. North Ave. Elmwood Park on January 29, 2019."

Your request has been granted in part and denied in part. Enclosed are records responsive to your FOIA request. However, please be advised that certain information in the records being provided has been determined to be exempt from disclosure under FOIA, and that information has been withheld or redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (b) of FOIA provides that "private information" is exempt from disclosure. "Private information" is defined in FOIA as, "unique identifiers, including a person's social security number, driver's license number, employee identification number, biometric identifiers, personal financial information, passwords or other access codes, medical records, home or personal telephone numbers, and personal email addresses. Private information also includes home address and personal license plates, except as otherwise provided by law or when compiled without possibility of attribution to any person." 5 ILCS 140/2 (c-5). Consequently, certain unique identifiers such as driver's license numbers, home or personal telephone numbers, home addresses, and personal license plates have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (c) of FOIA provides that, "[p]ersonal information contained within public records, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy ..." is exempt from

disclosure. Consequently, birthdates, an individual's race, a victim's name and identifying information, the names and identifying information of suspects who were never arrested, third party's name and identifying information, a minor's name and identifying information, and other personal information, the disclosure of which would constitute a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy, have been redacted from the records being provided.

Section 7 (1) (d) (iv) of FOIA provides that "[r]ecords in the possession of any public body created in the course of administrative enforcement proceedings, and any law enforcement or correctional agency for law enforcement purposes..." are exempt from disclosure, "but only to the extent that disclosure would...unavoidably disclose the identity of a confidential source, confidential information furnished only by the confidential source, or persons who file complaints with or provide information to administrative, investigative, law enforcement, or penal agencies..." Consequently, information that would reveal the identity of persons who have filed complaints with or who have provided information to the Village of Elmwood Park Police Department has been redacted from the records being provided.

The person responsible for the decision to deny a portion of your FOIA request is the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer, Gina Pesko. In accordance with Section 9(a) of FOIA, you are hereby notified that you have the right to file a Request for Review regarding the decision made by the Village of Elmwood Park Freedom of Information Officer with the Public Access Counselor at the Illinois Attorney General's Office. 

On 01/29/19, at 0339 hours, Sergeant Pankey, Officer Hock, Officer LaPenna, and I responded to 7440 W North Av (Trattoria Peppino's Restaurant) for a premise check, later classified as a burglary.

Officer Hock was first to arrive. Officer Hock checked the front and found the doors and windows to be secure. At the back of the exterior of the restaurant, Officer Hock observed damage to glass block window and a tool bag.

Sergeant Pankey, Officer Hock, Officer LaPenna, and I set up a perimeter as we waited for the owner, [REDACTED] to arrive.

[REDACTED] arrived to the scene and gave us keys to go inside. Sergeant Pankey, Officer Hock, and I entered through the front door and cleared the inside of the restaurant. No offenders were located inside. We did observe damage to the gaming area of the restaurant. The ATM door was open as well as the front of a gaming machine. It appeared these devices were forced open.

[REDACTED] advised the gaming machines are serviced by Gold Rush Gaming and the account manager is [REDACTED]. I spoke to [REDACTED] on the telephone. [REDACTED] said the ATM has silent alarms on the "cartridge". [REDACTED] said he received an alert that the alarm was going off from the ATM at Trattoria Peppino's restaurant at 0337 hours. [REDACTED] said he called the police at 0338 hours.

[REDACTED] said he has cameras inside the restaurant. [REDACTED] advised he will get the police a copy of the video footage as soon as possible. I viewed some of the video footage with [REDACTED]. On the video there appeared to be two subjects inside the restaurant using pry tools to gain access to a gaming machine and ATM. [REDACTED] advised that the offenders damaged the line for the rear camera to his business prior to making entry. [REDACTED] said USC was taken from the machines.

Both subjects appeared to be dressed in dark clothing with their faces covered. One subject had a dark line down the pant leg. One subject appeared to be wearing gloves and the other was seen not wearing gloves.

There is a camera at the property of [REDACTED]. Sergeant Pankey observed footwear impressions in the snow that appeared to be from Air Jordan shoes. The impressions indicated the subject was moving south bound.

Officer Messina arrived to the scene for processing and evidence collection. See Officer Messina's report.

[REDACTED] arrived on scene. [REDACTED] said he believes this burglary crew could be responsible for many others. [REDACTED] said our agency could call him if they needed further information.

The scene was turned back over to [REDACTED]

My tour of duty ended.

The following are my actions as an Evidence Technician for the reported Burglary at Peppino's (7440 W. North Avenue.)

After the scene was secure, I photographed the scene as it was.

Sergeant Pankey advised me of multiple shoe prints located outside the business, which were believed to belong to one of the offenders. I applied snow wax to two of the shoe prints and photographed them.

Sergeant Pankey and Officer Barrile advised me there were burglary tools left behind the business. I observed a large crowbar and a tool bag, containing multiple tools and a cash box, located in the snow, outside the point of entry. I collected all items.

Pankey and I spoke with the Gold Rush Gaming manager, [REDACTED] who asked if he could retrieve the cash from the inside of the cash boxes. Pankey and I placed on gloves, opened the cash box (retrieved from tool bag) and removed the cash, with [REDACTED] observing. Pankey laid out the cash and I photographed it.

[REDACTED] advised me there was another cash box dropped near the gambling machines, which we could collect, to be fingerprinted. [REDACTED] opened the box (with gloves on) and removed the cash. He turned over the box, to me, and I placed it in a paper bag.

I transported all collected evidence to our PD.

Once at the PD, I removed all contents from the tool bag and photographed them. I observed a Milwaukee Grinder tool (serial #F33DD1824 04494) and a Milwaukee extra battery, with the name CECCO written on it. I contacted WESCOM dispatch and had them run the grinder through LEADs. The LEADs search came back with no record on file.

I emailed WESCOM a copy of the report to enter the grinder tool into LEADs.

All collected evidence was inventoried per department policy, with pending lab submissions.
